ORDER
(U/S 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005)

Whereas, Transit Camps have been established in various locations in South Sikkim district for the accommodation of drivers and helpers transporting essential commodities and goods from outside the state.

Now, therefore in exercise of the powers conferred by section 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, I hereby direct the following guidelines to be strictly observed by the concerned officials, suppliers, pharmaceutical and other companies, drivers/helpers transporting essential commodities and goods in South Sikkim district during the period of lockdown till 3rd May, 2020 in all such Transit Camps in the District:

1. The Transit Camps have been established in the following locations under the overall supervision of the Nodal Officers designated:

2. Lodging facilities to drivers and helpers shall be made available free of cost.
3. **Bedding shall be arranged by drivers and helpers themselves.** However, profile/bed shall be arranged by the concerned Nodal Officer.
4. Food shall be made available at the rate of maximum Rs. 150/- per plate which shall be borne by the supplier/driver/helper. Nodal Officers shall make necessary arrangements and engage Self Help Groups for providing food for the drivers and helpers at the Transit Camp.
5. Medical facilities at the Transit Camps shall be arranged by CMO South and periodic screening of the drivers and helpers shall be done and proper records of the same shall be maintained.
6. Entry & Exit Register shall be maintained by Nodal Officer properly and Daily Reports shall be submitted by concerned SDMs and Nodal Officers.
7. District Project Officer/Disaster Management shall ensure sanitization of the Transit camps periodically.
8. Medical Emergency vehicles shall be arranged, if required, by the concerned SDM.
9. Television for entertainment of drivers and helpers shall be arranged by the Nodal Officers with assistance from NGOs and volunteers, if necessary.
10. Nodal Officers shall ensure that the drivers and helpers entering the Transit Camp shall compulsorily install Aarogya Setu Mobile App on their smart phones.
11. Nodal Officers shall engage the Safai Karmachari of the institution where the Transit Camps are established to ensure the cleanliness and hygienic surrounding of the premises.
12. Concerned SHOs shall ensure proper security of the premises and proper parking facility.
13. All Councillors of ULBs and Panchayat Presidents shall strictly ensure that no driver or helper of vehicles transporting essential commodities/goods from outside the state return to their residences and come into contact with family member or other residents. If any such driver or helper is found, the councilors or Panchayat Presidents shall immediately inform the aforementioned Nodal Officers. Such drivers and helpers to compulsorily stay in the designated Transit camps and concerned SDMs and Nodal Officers shall ensure the compliance of the same.
