**ORDER**

(U/S 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005)

Whereas positive case of COVID-19 has been detected in the following premise/building which may become a probable hotspot unless strict measures are taken immediately for the containment of the premises as per the guidelines of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.

Now therefore in exercise of powers u/s 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, I, M Bharani Kumar, IAS, District Magistrate-cum-Chairperson, District Disaster Management Authority, South Sikkim hereby direct the containment of the following premise.

1. The District Surveillance Officer shall trace all the contacts of the confirmed cases of COVID-19 and engage the health staff to monitor them during quarantine period.


2. If any of these primary contacts develop symptoms during this period of quarantine they shall be tested and treated as per the health protocol.

3. All primary contacts shall stay in home quarantine for a period of 11 days.

If any person fails to comply with the directions of the Incident Commander he/she shall be held responsible and action u/s 188 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, and this order shall be initiated against them.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect in the above specified area and shall remain valid till further orders.
