



**Subject:-Order under section 144 of CrPC read with relevant provisions under Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 and the Disaster Management Act, 2005 in connection with apprehended dangerto human safety – regarding.**

1. Whereas, it has been made to appear to me, in view of the situation emerging due to COVID-19 in District Baramulla, that there is sufficient ground for proceeding under Section 144 of CrPC for immediate prevention or speedy remedy is desirable to prevent danger to humanlife, health or safety ; and
2. Whereas, Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 and Disaster Management Act,2005 also empower the undersigned to issue certain directions for safety and preventing any harm to human life; and
3. Now, therefore, I, G. N. Itoo, KAS, District Magistrate, Baramulla, vide powers conferred upon me under section 144 of CrPC read with relevant provisions under the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 and the Disaster Management Act, 2005 do hereby order the following with effect from 8:00 pm on 22/03/2020 till 6:00 pm on 31/03/2020:-
  - i. that there shall be complete shutdown of all Anganwadi centers, Schools, Colleges, Universities, Malls, Gyms, shops, business establishments and markets etc., within the territorial jurisdiction of district Baramulla, except for the essential services and supply chains required to maintain the essential services, notified vide department of Food, Civil supplies and Consumer Affairs' Government Order No. 60-FCS&CA of 2020 dated 22/03/2020, issued vide endorsement number PS/Secy/FCSCA/01/2020 dated 22/03/2020;
  - ii. that there shall be complete restrictions on the movement of Inter-State /Intra State Buses; Matadors; and other modes of public transports, except for authorized SRTC buses plying for essential purposes.
  - iii. that there shall be complete ban on assembly of three or more persons for any reason whatsoever;
  - iv. that assemblies of any kind for demonstrations, rallies, processions, protests etc., are completely prohibited;
  - v. that gatherings of any kind (social/ cultural/ political/ religious/ academic/ sports/ seminar/ conference etc.,) shall be completely prohibited;
  - vi. that people are required to stay at home and come out only to procure essential commodities for consumption (one person per vehicle), in the immediate vicinity of their homes, while strictly following the norms of social distancing, provided further that there shall not be an assembly of more than three customers/clients in any establishment for seeking essential services. This

- shall particularly be ensured by the Banks, ATMs, Post Offices, Chemists and Grocery stores/shops.
- vii. that the passengers coming out from and going to the Airport shall be permitted to travel on production of air tickets. The staff deployed at Airport (public officials and belonging to Airlines) shall also be allowed to move on production of valid ID proof.
- viii. that government employees of essential services' departments or such other departments as required by government shall be permitted to move on production of ID proofs.
4. Since, it is not possible to serve prior notice of this order, it is as such being issued ex-parte. Any violation of this order shall invite punitive action under section 188 of Indian Penal Code and other relevant sections of Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 and the Disaster Management Act, 2005.
5. This order shall be widely circulated for information of all by the Director, Information and Public Relations.

Whereas, health advisory has been issued in view of the situation emerged due to spread of Corona Virus-19 which has affected several countries across the world;

Whereas, it has been observed that the transmission of the said disease may increase rapidly in case prescribed preventive measures/protocols, which includes avoiding of mass gatherings, are not followed strictly;


Whereas, in the interest of public health and to prevent the spread of the disease, it has become imperative for the administration to restrict the mass gatherings/crowds/ congregations/functions in the district.

Now, therefore in view of the above mentioned facts and circumstances I, Dr. G. N. Itoo, KAS District Magistrate Baramulla in exercise of powers vested in me under section 144 of Cr.P.C, do hereby impose restriction/ban over the assembly/gathering of more than 05 persons at any public place across in the entire district Baramulla including all towns and villages with immediate effect and shall remain in force till further orders. However, in case of emergency or special requirement, the concerned shall obtain prior permission from the undersigned, ADM or SDM concerned.



Subject:- N-Corona Virus 2019- imposition of complete lock down in District Baramulla.

ORDER

In continuation to this office order No.60/DMB/2020 dated 18-03-2020 and No. DCB/PS/9242-57 dated 19-03-2020, with regard to imposition of various restrictions to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the district, it is hereby ordered, in the interest of public health and to stop the outbreak of the said disease, all the shops/ business establishments except the medical shops, shall remain closed in whole district Baramulla. Besides, there shall be no movement of any kind of transport including towns and villages except government vehicles/ ambulances/ vehicles of medical staff/ employees connected with efforts against COVID-19. Further, no vehicle from border districts shall be allowed to enter in this district except those connected with emergency services like ambulance, vehicle carrying medical staff and the staff engaged in fighting COVID-19. In case violation is reported by any person, strict punitive action shall be taken against him.

This order shall have immediate effect and will remain in force till further order.

**ORDER**

Whereas, Novel Corona Virus Disease -2019 (NCOVID-19) has been declared as global pandemic by WHO in view of its outbreak across the globe;

Whereas various advisories and orders have been issued by the Health authorities and by this office as a precautionary measure from time to time to restrict the spread of this disease which includes ban on social gatherings, steps/directions issued in pursuance to Epidemic Disease Act 1897 and imposition of Section 144 Cr.P.C for restriction/ban on the assembly/gathering of more than 05 persons at any public place within the territorial jurisdiction of District Baramulla.


Whereas, in view of the detection of one case of Corona Virus-19 in District Srinagar, it has become imperative for the administration to take further measures to restrict the spread of the disease.

Now, therefore, in view of the circumstances referred to above, the following restrictions are hereby imposed within the territorial jurisdiction of District Baramulla.

1. No public transport shall ply in the district till 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2020. However, plying of Sumos/Auto Rickshaws, shall be reviewed after three days.
2. All Restaurants, Open Food Courts, Roadside Eateries, Gym Centres, Beauty Parlours, Snooker Clubs and Parks shall remain closed.

However, these restrictions shall not apply to the Govt Vehicles/ ambulances/ Govt Staff involved in efforts against COVID19 & staff connected with emergency services.

This order shall have immediate effect, till further orders.


**Subject:-** Restriction on entry of foreign tourists in District Baramulla.


Whereas, Noval Corona Virus Disease -2019 (NCOVID-19) has been declared as global pandemic by WHO in view of its outbreak across the globe;
