ORDER

Vide order dated 28.09.2020 the undersigned has passed an order to kept in abeyance the order for eviction passed on date 16.09.2020, till the stay order passed by the Dwarka Court will not be vacated.

Today, the complainant had present the copy of a order 24.09.2020 passed by the Dwarka Court in MC No.140/2020 wherein it is provided that the respondent no.2 herein can be evicted with "*due process of law*" from the suit property.

That the present forum is also a court of law and after adopting and following the due process of law the respondent was directed to vacate the suit premises.

Thus, in terms of order dated 24.09.2020, the undersigned set-aside the order dated 28.09.2020 and the order dated 16.09.2020 will remain effective.
