

## ORDER

Whereas, an order passed by Chief Secretary-cum-Chairperson Haryana State Executive Committee no. DMC-SPIO-2020/13250 on dated 9<sup>th</sup> November 2020 wherein it is directed to ensure the implementation of the order of Hon'ble NGT dated 09/11/2020 (OA No. 249 of 2020) in letter and in spirit with immediate effect.

And whereas I am satisfied that for immediate compliance of the aforesaid order of Hon'ble NGT a complete ban is required to be imposed on the sale and use of any kind of fire cracker in District Jhajjar.

Now, therefore, I, Jitender Kumar, I.A.S., District Magistrate, Jhajjar, in exercise of powers vested in me U/S 144 Cr.Pc. 1973, the explosive rules, 2008 and other enabling powers to me as District Magistrate, Jhajjar under the laws and in compliance of the order of the Hon'ble NGT dated 9.11.2020 in OA No. 249 of 2020 and in the interest of health & safety of the general public and to avoid danger to the human life and to control the pollution do hereby impose complete ban on sale and use of any kind of fire crackers in the territorial limit of district Jhajjar.

This order shall come into force with effect from midnight of November 10-11, 2020 and will remain in force till midnight of 30<sup>th</sup> November-December 1, 2020.

The Superintendent of Police, Jhajjar, Additional District Magistrate, Jhajjar, District Municipal Commissioner, Jhajjar, All Sub-Divisional Magistrates, City Magistrate, Jhajjar, DDPO, Jhajjar, RO, PCB, Bahadurgah, All Tehsildar/Naib Tehsildar's, DSP's, BDPO's, EO/Secy. Municipal Councils/Committees, SHO's of all police stations, Fire officer and other fire department staff of District Jhajjar shall ensure the compliance of this order. All officers are directed to conduct raids along with SHO concerned, wherever it seems necessary and initiate penal action as warranted.

Any violation of this order would be punishable under section 188 of IPC and Explosives Act 1884/Explosives Rules 2008 or any other provision applicable in this regard for the time being in force.

The District Public Relation Officer, Jhajjar give wide publicity to this order throughout the district Jhajjar and this order should also be sent to press for wide publicity. DIO, Jhajjar is directed to post the order on official website [www.jhajjar.nic.in](http://www.jhajjar.nic.in).

It is not possible to serve this notice to the public at large individually, so in view of emergent situation, this order is passed ex-parte and is addressed to public at large.
