ORDER

Whereas, in pursuance of the directions issued by the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Government of Himachal Pradesh, vide letter No. HFW-A-A(3)-1/2020 dated 16th March, 2020, the undersigned had prohibited the entry of general public in the religious places/places of worship situated in the jurisdiction of District Bilaspur till further orders vide Order No. BLS-DEV-12(6)/2018-13780-82 dated 18th March, 2020.

And whereas, on 4th June, 2020 the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India has issued SOPs to be followed at religious places/places of worship.

And whereas, the Additional Chief Secretary (LAC) to the Government of Himachal Pradesh vide Order No. LCD-B(12)-1/2017 dated 5th September, 2020 has issued directions to all concerned authorities of HP to ensure strict implementation of above mentioned directions/SOPs dated 4th June, 2020 as issued by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, besides certain other additional SOPs/directions.

Now, therefore, keeping in view the Order dated 5th September, 2020 issued by the Additional Chief Secretary (LAC) to the Government of Himachal Pradesh, I, Rajeshwar Goel, IAS, District Magistrate Bilaspur do hereby order that religious places/places of worship situated in District Bilaspur shall be opened for the general public with effect from 10th September, 2020, subject to strict compliance of the directions/SOPs issued on dated 4th June, 2020 by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, which are annexed herewith as "Annexure-A" and further the additional SOPs/directions for religious places annexed as "Annexure B".
