ORDER

Whereas the Election Commission of India has announced the schedule for holding General Elections to Lok Sabha and State Legislative Assembly on 10/03/2019 Press Note No. ECI/PN/23/2019. Dated 10/03/2019.

AND

Whereas, in order to conduct the ensuing General Election, 2019 peacefully in the entire area of the district of Papum Pare, it is necessary to impose certain restriction of licensed Arms.

AND

Whereas, license holders and license arms in this district based on the criteria such as persons involved in criminal cases, violence and rioting, released on balls and or apprehension that they may misuse their fire arms or may get involved in any law and order problem or in threatening the other persons, some preventive measures are required to be taken.


Therefore, I Dr. Joram Beda, IAS, District Magistrate, Papum Pare, in exercise of the power conferred upon me u/s.17 (3)(b) of the Arms Act, 1959 (Act. No. 54 of 1959) and the Arms Rules, 1962 read with the Indian Arms Act, 1878 do hereby direct as per provisions of Section 21(1) of the said act that all the licensees of Fire Arms of this district shall mandatorily deposit their fire arms to the respective police stations and the same will remain deposited till one week after the counting is over i.e. till completion of Election Process. Institutional license holders like Banks, may apply for exemption, with reasons to the concerned Police Station who has jurisdiction of the area, from this order, making out their case with appropriate documents.

The sportsmen who are the members of National Rifle Association, at different levels and have to participate in various sporting events, in which they use their rifles, will be exempted from these restrictions.

Further, order is passed to the effect that the respective Office – in- Charge of the Police Station shall deposit the Fire Arms of the License in the armory of the Police Station under a proper acknowledgement to the license and would hand over back the said Fire Arms to the license on or after 30-05-2019. They are also directed to serve the notices all the Arms License holders of the District immediately.

The License Arms shall be deposited by the licensee within 7 days after the receipt of notice if not otherwise exempted.
