ADVISORY

In view of incessant rain during the post few days, it has been observed that massive landslides/mudslides/road blockades leading to vehicular accidents and loss of life and properties.

Due to such landslides and bad condition of roads, road accidents and cases of deaths were reported.

In this connection, following advisory is issued to all concerned for strict compliance to avoid unwanted incidents.

1. General publics are advised not to travel during night hours in the district till the monsoon is off set.
2. All the Principals, Head Masters and Teachers in-charges of all schools in Papum Pare District are advised to instruct the drivers of the school buses to take maximum precaution and observe the condition of roads while carrying students to avoid accidents.
3. All Administrative Officers are advised to keep strict watch in their jurisdiction about the incidents and kept informed the District Administration by immediate means.
4. All the Executive Engineers (PWD/ Highway) are advised to keep men and machinery in the vulnerable points to clear such road blockades.
