PROHIBITORY ORDER

WHEREAS, it has been reported that there have been rampant earth cutting going on at various locations on the both sides of the Papu-Yupia-Hoj-Potin road (NH-713A & NH-13).

AND WHEREAS, such illegal earth cutting leads to mudslides/landslides which in turn endangers human lives and properties and also causes blockade/damages of Right of Way (RoW) causing lots of inconvenience to the public travelling through the road.

AND WHEREAS, This causes obstructions and also poses threat to lives and properties.

AND WHEREAS, as per Section 30(1) of the Disaster Management Act'2005: the District Authority shall act as the district planning, coordinating and implementing body for disaster management and take all measure for the purpose of disaster management in the district in accordance with the guidelines laid down by the National authority and the State Authority,

AND WHEREAS, as per Section 34 of the Disaster Management Act' 2005 for purpose of assisting protecting or providing relief to the community, in response to any threatening disaster situation or disaster the District Authority may...

(m) take such other steps as may be required or warranted to be taken in such a situation.

THEREFORE, I, Shri Vikram Singh Malik, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Papumpare District, Yupia in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 30(1) and Section 34 of the Disaster Management Act' 2005 , do hereby order that:-

- (a) Earth cutting along the Papu-Yupia-Hoj-Potin road (NH-713A & NH-13) is banned for a period of 3 (Three) months from the date of issue of this order.
- (b) The owners of the land will clear the accumulated mud from the road and will ensure that no mud get accumulated on the road henceforth.
- (c) The ADC HQ, Yupia and SDO, Doimukh should take immediate necessary action to stop such activities. The defaulters should be booked under appropriate section of Law.
- (d) The Superintendent of Police, Yupia will deploy sufficient Police force on requirement for the purpose.
- (e) Any complaints/emergencies in this regard may be intimated on the following numbers:

Any damages caused to public properties such as roads, bridges, traveling and conveying property etc due to negligence of the owners of private lands/non compliance of the order shall be booked under Section 431 of IPC and Section 51 (b) of The Disaster Management Act, 2005. The FIR shall be registered by the respective Circle Officer under the mentioned sections of IPC and The Disaster Management Act, 2005.
