

## **Member of Legislative Assembly Constituency Development Scheme (MLACDS)**

- ❖ Member of Legislative Assembly Constituency Development Scheme (MLACDS) is being implemented in Tamil Nadu in order to identify and execute the essential infrastructure works in the assembly constituencies.
- ❖ The MLAs identify infrastructure gaps in the constituencies and propose the works to be executed under the scheme.
- ❖ The scheme is being implemented both rural and urban areas. From 2011 – 12 onwards, the fund allocation per constituency under the scheme had been increased from Rs. 1.75 Crore to Rs.2.00 crore Now as per G.O.136, RD &PR the allocation of fund to each MLA is raised to Rs.2.50 Crore.
- ❖ Under Member of Legislative Assembly Constituency Development Scheme, an allocation of Rs.1.10 Crore should be earmarked for 'tide component' which is to be mandatorily earmarked for priority works.
- ❖ The remaining 'untied component' of Rs.90 lakhs, the Member of Legislative Assembly can choose any works of their choice not falling within the 'negative list' of the works earmarked under 'tied component' also.
- ❖ **Rs.25.00 lakhs for infrastructure to schools** : In order to provide infrastructure facilities to Schools (Corporation /Municipalities / Panchayat Union / Government School only) a sum of at least Rs.25.00 lakh per MLA shall be earmarked under the tied component.
- ❖ **1.2. Rs.20.00 lakh for Anganwadi / Kitchen Shed / Modernisation of Kitchen Shed** : For the construction of Anganwadi Buildings / Noon Meal Centres / Noon Meal Kitchen Sheds in rural and urban areas and also for modernizing the Anganwadi Kitchen Sheds with Gas connection etc.,
- ❖ **1.3.Rs.15.00 lakh for water supply** : In order to mitigate the water supply scarcity, especially in summer, water supply workse

specially augmentation of existing source, provision of individual power pump works, mini power pump works etc.,

- ❖ **1.4.Rs.50.00 lakh for other tied works** : Under the tied component, the MLA can choose one or more of the following works for any amount according to his / her choice, subject to the overall ceiling of Rs.50.00 lakh.

## **Rural / Urban Areas**

1. Installation of Solar street lights in rural / urban areas / Roof top solar power in Government Buildings / LED street lights in Urban areas.
2. Up-gradation of gravel / WBM Roads to BT standard.
3. Renewal of badly worn BT road (laying of BT layer only by filling up of potholes if necessary).
4. Laying of Cement Concrete Roads.
5. Provision of rooms, buildings and / or compound wall for Government and local body Hospitals, Primary Health Centres, Government Veterinary Hospitals, Government Schools, Panchayat Union Schools, Adi Schools, Kallar reclamation Schools, Government Colleges and Government Hostels, Government ITI and Government Polytechnics
6. Provision of infrastructural facilities to Government Special School for the differently abled and Government Orphanages.
7. Construction of bridges.
8. Provision of additional Burial Grounds / Cremation Grounds / Compound Walls.
9. Provision of compound wall / fencing in the burial grounds belonging to public Wakfs registered with Wakf Board.
10. Construction of integrated Sanitary for women and men.
11. Construction of Public Distribution shop buildings.
12. Construction of buildings for physical fitness centre / Gymnasium.
13. Provision of Concrete Pavement with storm water drains.
14. Formation of new Public Parks

15. Purchase of Jetrodding Machines and hydraulically operated sewerage Machines.

## **2. Works to be taken up under untied component of Rs. 90.00 lakhs :**

Any work not falling within the following 'negative list / prohibited works' can be taken up under the untied component of MLACDS. Works falling under the tied component can also be taken up under untied component for Rs.90.00 lakh.

### **Negative List / Prohibited Works**

The following works under the 'Negative list / Prohibited works' cannot be taken up under the MLACDS unless specifically include in the exceptions

- ❖ Construction of Office and residential buildings belonging to Central and State Governments.
- ❖ Assets for individual / family benefits.
- ❖ All renovation, maintenance and repair works.
- ❖ Purchase of all movable items, equipments and furniture.

- ❖ Any work in Government aided and Self Financing Schools and Colleges.
- ❖ All works involving Commercial establishment / units.
- ❖ Works within the places of religious worship and on land belonging to or owned by religious faiths / groups.
- ❖ Desilting of ponds, ooranies, rivers, tanks, canals, channels and the like.
- ❖ Gravel / WBM roads.
- ❖ Installation of High Mast Lights

**Exception**

- ❖ Compound wall for MLA office if not yet been constructed.
- ❖ Construction of Maintenance sheds, Compound walls and concrete flooring for Bus depots of State Transport undertaking,
- ❖ Purchase of furniture and equipments for Government Schools, Colleges / Hostels / Hospitals / Primary Health Centres / Veterinary Hospitals / Polytechnics.
- ❖ Purchase of aids and appliances for differently abled persons.
- ❖ Purchase of CP chair for Polio and stroke attacked persons and purchase of mentally challenged Learning Kits for mentally challenged children learning in Government special schools.
- ❖ Purchase of physical exercise equipments to be installed in the physical fitness centre / Gymnasium belonging to local body.
- ❖ Purchase of equipments for installation of solar photovoltaic items in the existing Government buildings.
- ❖ Under MLACDS, an overall allocation of 21% of the total allocation under MLACDS should be made for areas predominantly inhabited by SC/ST persons in rural areas and for persons living in slums in urban area.
