

Gadag District : Census 2011 Data

An official Census 2011 detail of Gadag, a district of Karnataka has been released by Directorate of Census Operations in Karnataka. Enumeration of key persons was also done by census officials in Gadag District of Karnataka.

In 2011, Gadag had population of 1,064,570 of which male and female were 537,147 and 527,423 respectively. In 2001 census, Gadag had a population of 971,835 of which males were 493,533 and remaining 478,302 were females. Gadag District population constituted 1.74 percent of total Maharashtra population. In 2001 census, this figure for Gadag District was at 1.84 percent of Maharashtra population.

There was change of 9.54 percent in the population compared to population as per 2001. In the previous census of India 2001, Gadag District recorded increase of 13.13 percent to its population compared to 1991.

Gadag District Density 2011

The initial provisional data released by census India 2011, shows that density of Gadag district for 2011 is 229 people per sq. km. In 2001, Gadag district density was at 209 people per sq. km. Gadag district administers 4,657 square kilometers of areas.

Gadag Literacy Rate 2011

Average literacy rate of Gadag in 2011 were 75.12 compared to 66.11 of 2001. If things are looked out at gender wise, male and female literacy were 84.66 and 65.44 respectively. For 2001 census, same figures stood at 79.32 and 52.52 in Gadag District. Total literate in Gadag District were 700,177 of which male and female were 397,178 and 302,999 respectively. In 2001, Gadag District had 551,362 in its district.

Gadag Sex Ratio 2011

With regards to Sex Ratio in Gadag, it stood at 982 per 1000 male compared to 2001 census figure of 969. The average national sex ratio in India is 940 as per latest reports of Census 2011 Directorate. In 2011 census, child sex ratio is 947 girls per 1000 boys compared to figure of 952 girls per 1000 boys of 2001 census data.

Gadag Child Population 2011

In census enumeration, data regarding child under 0-6 age were also collected for all districts including Gadag. There were total 132,442 children under age of 0-6 against 137,835 of 2001 census. Of total 132,442 male and female were 68,025 and 64,417 respectively. Child Sex Ratio as per census 2011 was 947 compared to 952 of census 2001. In 2011, Children under 0-6 formed 12.44 percent of Gadag District compared to 14.18 percent of 2001. There was net change of -1.74 percent in this compared to previous census of India.

Gadag Houseless Census

In 2011, total 377 families live on footpath or without any roof cover in Gadag district of Karnataka. Total Population of all who lived without roof at the time of Census 2011 numbers to 1,528. This approx 0.14% of total population of Gadag district.

Gadag Population 2015

What is the population of Gadag in 2015? The fact is, last census for Gadag district was done only in 2011 and next such census would only be in 2021. There is no actual figure for population of Gadag district situated in Karnataka. As per 2011, Gadag population is 1,064,570.

Gadag District Urban/Rural 2011

Out of the total Gadag population for 2011 census, 35.63 percent lives in urban regions of district. In total 379,309 people lives in urban areas of which males are 189,562 and females are 189,747. Sex Ratio in urban region of Gadag district is 1001 as per 2011 census data. Similarly child sex ratio in Gadag district was 950 in 2011 census. Child population (0-6) in urban region was 45,092 of which males and females were 23,127 and 21,965. This child population figure of Gadag district is 12.20 % of total urban population. Average literacy rate in Gadag district as per census 2011 is 80.94 % of which males and females are 88.01 % and 73.92 % literates respectively. In actual number 270,504 people are literate in urban region of which males and females are 146,477 and 124,027 respectively.

As per 2011 census, 64.37 % population of Gadag districts lives in rural areas of villages. The total Gadag district population living in rural areas is 685,261 of which males and females are 347,585 and 337,676 respectively. In rural areas of Gadag district, sex ratio is 971 females per 1000 males. If child sex ratio data of Gadag district is considered, figure is 946 girls per 1000 boys. Child population in the age 0-6 is 87,350 in rural areas of which males were 44,898 and females were 42,452. The child population comprises 12.92 % of total rural population of Gadag district. Literacy rate in rural areas of Gadag district is 71.86 % as per census data 2011. Gender wise, male and female literacy stood at 82.83 and 60.62 percent respectively. In total, 429,673 people were literate of which males and females were 250,701 and 178,972 respectively.
