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**Subject: Minutes of Meeting held on solid waste management on 19-11-2020,
at ADDC office, Minis Secretariat Complex Bandipore.**

Solid Waste Management is a global problem and with every passing day the magnitude and spread of Waste is increasing significantly. Bandipore is also affected with Solid Waste , however, District Administration Bandipore is taking this biggest challenge head on and three pronged strategy is being adopted in Rural , Urban areas and around Wular Lake.

In consonance with stated backdrop, a meeting was held for Rural waste management under the Chairmanship of ADDC Bandipore on 19th November, in which Joint Director Planning, District Panchayat Officer, Xen Rural Engineering Wing, BDO Bandipore also participated besides other stakeholders.

A model was rolled out starting from Household (HHs) registration in every Panchayats. Based on HHs strength, collection of waste shall be done by person(s) hired by PRIs /BDOs on fixed charges from HHs. Collection chambers, one per 450 HHs shall be constructed as per type design prepared by Xen REW. There will also be mini landfill /Dumping places to act as intermediary reserved places for actual disposal through large landfills /Cluster Solid waste plants, as per availability of land identified by DPO/Revenue authorities. It was however reiterated that public has to come forward and cooperate fully.

To give legal teeth to the enforcement, Panchayat Raj Act and water acts shall be used besides other Polythene ban orders in Vogue.

The following instructions with timelines were fixed for rolling out model as quickly as possible. Moreover, there will be two tier monitoring team of officers/officials for sustenance of the model.

- ⊕ DPO Bandipore to submit Panchayat wise plan with estimates of Collection centers within weeks time. Xen REW to instruct AEEs/AEs/JEs accordingly. One centre per 450 HHs be ensured.
- ⊕ Sites for construction be got identified by DPO / BDOs in consultation with PRIs.
- ⊕ ACD Bandipore to work with PRIs on identification of Minimum Persons required and nominal charges (Normal & BPL) for each HH in Panchayats. The charges shall be approved by ADDC Bandipore.

- ⊥ PRIs / Public be asked for active involvement of Now or Never Campaign and strict enforcement be ensured post awareness by ground officials of Rural Development Department.
- ⊥ Converged approach be adopted for speedier results and desired outcome.
