(This order shall replace order issued vide letter No. 227/ MB (Camp) dated 11-12-2020 with immediate effect)

Order

Whereas, from the information gathered from various sources, including intelligence reports by the state and the central agencies, there is an apprehension that because of on-going agitation by farmers and possibility of few anti-social elements taking law into their hands, there is a possibility of violence and breakdown of law and order.

And, whereas, in the exercise of powers vested with the undersigned under the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 and as per "The Haryana Epidemic Disease COVID-19 Regulations, 2020" notified in consonance with the Epidemic Disease Act, 1897 issued for the prevention and containment of COVID-19, by the Govt of Haryana, it has become critical to prohibit the movement and congregation of individuals making attempts to block railway lines and **all major National Highways/State Highways and other District Roads in the jurisdiction of District Nuh**, to secure the lives of the public in general and those protesting individuals in particular, on account of severe & intensifying cold and also potential aggravation of pandemic. Hence, **I, Dharendra Khadgata, District Magistrate, Nuh** declare all such movements and congregation of people more than five in number armed with lathis, dandas, bhalas, arms or any instruments etc., illegal. These orders shall not apply to essential services which are mentioned in the annexure to this order, so as to maintain constant supply of health care and goods.

Now, therefore, **I, Dharendra Khadgata, District Magistrate, Nuh** in the exercise of powers conferred under Section 144 of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 hereby order that no such assembly of persons shall conduct all such movements / blockages of highways and railroads, and congregation of people more than five in number armed with lathis, dandas, bhalas, arms or any instruments etc.in the District. Every such assembly is declared unlawful as per Section 141 of IPC, 1860 and hence, prohibited in the entire District till further orders. In view of the emergent nature of the situation, this order is being passed ex-parte, to be promulgated through the District Information and Public Relations Officer.

To ensure compliance of this order the following directions are issued:

- i. People are required to stay at home and come out only for accessing basic and essential services as and when allowed by district Administration.
- ii. Any congregation of five or more persons is prohibited in public places.
- iii. **The Schedule I annexed with this order shall exhaustively determine the list of personnel (including their vehicles) and services which are exempted from application of this order.**
- iv. Government employees tasked with emergency & essential services of law & order, health, Fire & Ambulance, Municipal Services, water supply and electricity

services, print & electronic media, Banks, Insurance, movement of food stuffs and Government machinery tasked with responsibility related to containment of Covid-19 shall be allowed to move unhindered upon production of their Identity Cards. Personnel of Medical Education & Research department and Health services personnel such as Doctors, Nurses, Paramedical, Pharmacists, chemists and all other staff shall be allowed to attend duties **on production of ID cards** from their respective departments/institutions whether Government or Private. Personnel engaged in movement of foodstuffs viz. food-grains, fruits/vegetables, milk etc. shall be allowed to deliver their products. Personnel of Private Security Agencies, Airports, Postal/Telecom and ISPs allowed to report to their places of duty.

- v. The Executive Magistracy, all personnel in Uniform at the service of the Govt like police personnel, Home Guards, Para Military & Military, Fire & Ambulance, Electricity and Media, Health department personnel and other personnel tasked with responsibilities related to COVID19, shall be allowed to move unhindered.
- vi. Government employees of non-emergency departments but on official duty shall be allowed to move unhindered upon production of ID card.
- vii. **This order shall come into force w.e.f 10:00 AM on 12th December, 2020 till further orders.**
- viii. The compliance shall be ensured by all Executive Magistrates/Police Officials on duty and the violations may be sternly dealt as per sections of 188 (to be read with 195 of Criminal Procedure Code), 269 and 270, Indian Penal Code, 1860.
- ix. The order shall be promulgated by placing this order on District website, circulating through community social media software groups and other relevant digital methods. Wherever such promulgation is not possible through digital methods, tools of mass communication like Radio and Television shall be used and also the publicity vans.

Schedule I - Exemptions

Note: Establishment if mentioned, includes staff and the vehicles necessary to move personnel & goods.

- I. All offices tasked with maintenance of Law & order, Magisterial Duties, Health services, Police/Military/Paramilitary, National Informatics Centre (NIC),
 - II. Citizens with emergent medical conditions including Pregnant women expected to deliver in ensuing months at Government/Private health facilities.
 - III. Judiciary – Judges and supporting staff authorised by Session Judge
 - IV. Village Panchayats– Sarpanches/Nambardar with two vehicles
 - V. Government Treasuries and staff thereof
 - VI. Municipal, Ambulance and Fire Services.
 - VII. Hospitals, chemists, optical stores, laboratories including medicines/medicinal production units and oxygen cylinders production units
 - VIII. Banks/ ATMs
 - IX. Press & Media offices
 - X. IT/ITeS companies – BPOs
 - XI. Distribution System/ Fair Price Shops - personnel and other NGOs/ RWAs as mentioned below.
- Redcross or any other mentioned by any specific order.**
- XII. Personnel of Prison/ Jails Dept on duty
 - XIII. Private Security Agencies personnel
 - XIV. Personnel related to all essential services including electricity, water, telecommunication/BPO, HSVP, postal and internet services on showing of Identity Card
 - XV. Print & electronic media including All India Radio
 - XVI. All establishments tasked with functions related to expenditure of the state including pay & accounts offices and Excise & Taxation/GST.
 - XVII. Petrol pumps, LPG agencies, natural gas related establishments including logistics
 - XVIII. All establishments related to animal fodder and animal disease management
 - XIX. All bodies related to supply of milk and logistics
 - XX. All persons and vehicles engaged in movement of medicines, animal feed, foodstuffs
 - XXI. Retailers of foodstuffs, groceries, milk
 - XXII. Restaurants, Eateries, Kitchens, Canteens/ ATAL canteens– only takeaway (seating not permitted) or providing home delivery
 - XXIII. Manufacture, transport, delivery of drinking water cans, bottles and packaged water
 - XXIV. Godowns & Warehouses.
 - XXV. Home Delivery of newspapers and goods purchased through e-commerce
 - XXVI. Vehicles/Cabs for moving personnel/goods of exempted categories
 - XXVII. Taxis authorised by district administration for moving from home to hospitals
 - XXVIII. Government vehicles engaged in essential services/duties
 - XXIX. All private establishments that support the above services or area linked to the efforts for containment of Covid-19.
