

ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973

The following forthcoming **Secondary and Sr. Secondary Exam-2021 (Compartment and Additional Subject)** are being conducted by the **Board of School Education, Haryana, Bhiwani** at various examinations centres in District Nuh on dated 19.01.2021.

It has been made to appear to me that crowd may assemble around the examination centers and may create obstructions, disturbance or interference in the smooth and peaceful running of the said examination.

The **Secretary, Board of School Education, Haryana, Bhiwani** has also requested that law and order should be maintained during the examination day and public assembly be avoided around the following examination centres :-

Sr. No.	Examination Centre
1.	Nuh-3, Govt. Girls Sr. Sec. School, Behind Hindu Sr. Sec. School.
2.	Nuh-4 (B-1), Hindu Sr. Sec. School
3.	Nuh-15 (B-1), Govt. Sr. Sec. School, Ferozpur Namak.

Whereas, I am satisfied that in order to avoid disturbance & unnecessary interference in the examination centres, directions to impose restrictions on free movement of persons around a radius of 200 meters of the above examination centres are necessary.

Now, therefore, in the exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, **I, Dharendra Khadgata, IAS, District Magistrate, Nuh** do hereby prohibit the free movement of persons and operation of photostat machines within a limit of 200 meters radius of the examination centers of the District Nuh during the examination day, i.e. 19.01.2021.


This order shall not apply to police and public servants on duty. This order shall be promulgated throughout the revenue limits of Nuh District by beat of drums, by announcement through publicity van of Public Relation Department and by affixing copies of this order on the notice board of District, Sub Divisional and Tehsil offices and the other public places as well as the examination centers of the District Nuh.

In view of the requirement of the situation which has been become emergent, this order is passed ex-parte and is addressed to the public in general.

For the violation of the aforesaid order if any person is found guilty, he will be liable for punishment under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.
