Subject: Regarding vaccination of staff/employees/workers on priority basis within six weeks.

Sir/Madam,

As you know that there is widespread prevalence of COVID-19 in border districts of Punjab adjoining District Una with high rates of positivity. Several daily commuters enter Una from these districts as shopkeepers and to work in private/Government offices & industries and similarly several of them go from Una to these districts on daily basis. These daily commuters pose a significant risk of carrying COVID-19 infection in and out of our local population & are at grave risk themselves. It is important that these workers/employees/shopkeepers are vaccinated at earliest because of their role in maintaining critical infrastructure operations as vaccination gives an added layer of protection against COVID-19 and could also be useful in protecting the coworkers and their families.

Therefore you are directed to ensure maximum vaccination of all daily commuters coming to Una district from surrounding border areas of Punjab i.e. Employees of all Governments and private institutions, private clinics, Shopkeepers, labourers/workers/employees in industries etc. within next six weeks

on priority basis. All such workers/staff/employees/shopkeepers should be informed & motivated for vaccination & responsibility should be given to their employees to ensure their vaccination within 6 weeks. Database & vaccination status of all such persons be compiled at the earliest.
