**ORDER**

In continuation of orders no. 667-691/DRO/Relief dated 06.05.2021, 723-751/DRO/Relief dated 09.05.2021, 834-861/DRO/Relief dated 15.05.2021, 951-986/DRO/Relief dated 19.05.2021, 1044-1056/DRO/Relief dated 21.05.2021 and 1081-1108/DRO/Relief dated 25.05.2021 after considering the current situation of COVID-19 pandemic and fatalities in the District, I, Raghav Sharma, IAS, District Magistrate-cum-Chairperson, DDMA, Una, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Sections 33 and 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and in welfare of the public at large, do hereby order and direct that restrictions imposed vide aforementioned orders shall stand further extended till 6:00 AM of 7<sup>th</sup> June 2021 with following modifications with effect from 6:00 AM of 31<sup>st</sup> May 2021:

1. The timings for markets/ bazaars and shops shall be as follows:

(i) From Monday to Friday

Shops which can open from 9 AM to 2 PM	All markets/shops
--	-------------------

(ii) During Saturday & Sunday

Shops which can open from 9 AM to 2 PM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Shops registered solely for fruits &amp; vegetables</li><li>• Shops registered solely as milk &amp; dairy booths</li></ul>
Shops which will remain closed	All other shops not covered in above categories including halwai shops, sweet shops, bhujia shops, bakeries etc.

The shopkeepers and buyers shall ensure compliance of COVID-19 appropriate behavior and safety protocols as per Health Department instructions.


- (iii) Fair Price Shops (under Targeted Public Distribution System) in district Una shall be allowed to open on Tuesday to Sunday from 10 AM to 5 PM and will remain closed on every Monday.
- (iv) There shall be no timing restriction for shops registered as medicine/ chemist shops and hotels.
- (v) There shall be no public seating in dhabas, restaurants and eating joints which shall only give option of take-away or home-delivery.

2. All the stand alone offices with strength of up to 4 employees shall remain open with full strength and other offices of Government Departments/ PSUs/ Local Bodies/ Autonomous Bodies will operate with 30% attendance. The Head of Departments/Head of Offices shall take the decision on actual roster as per requirement. The offices shall ensure compliance of COVID-19 appropriate behavior and safety protocols in the work place. The employees with disability, pregnant/lactating women shall however be not asked to attend offices and continue working from home. Similarly all employees not in roster shall be available for call up at short notice if required by the Head of Office. The Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh will issue separate orders with respect to office restrictions in Hon'ble Court and all other Judicial offices.

All educational, training, coaching institutions etc. shall continue to remain closed further orders.

Any person violating these curfew measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act-2005, Section 188 of the IPC, Section 111 read with Section 114 & 115 of HP Police Act-2007 and other legal provisions as applicable.


