ORDER

In partial modification of order no. 545-572/DRO/Relief-DDMA dated 06-01-2022 and in compliance of order no. Rev (DMC)(C)20-2/2020-COVID-19 Government of Himachal Pradesh, Revenue Department- Disaster Management Cell dated 05-01-2022, I, Raghav Sharma, IAS, District Magistrate-cum- Chairperson, DDMA, Una in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Sections 33 and 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and in welfare of the public at large, do hereby order that:

1. There shall be Night Curfew in the District from 10 PM to 5 AM. However, this order shall not be applicable to the following persons and vehicles:-
 - i. Govt. servants on Magisterial/ Law & order duty and officials of District Disaster Management Authority.
 - ii. Officials of Health and Ayush Department including persons working in private health establishments, while on duty.
 - iii. Movement to/ from industrial units & factories, subject to production of valid employee ID card issued by the unit/ issued by GM DIC Una.
 - iv. Fire Service(s).
 - v. Police, Military, Para Military Forces and other security forces which are under the control of State or Central Government.
 - vi. Government or Semi Government Employees on duty pertaining to mitigation of COVID-19 subject to production of valid ID cards or as certified by concerned Sub-Divisional Magistrate.
 - vii. Electricity, Water and Municipal services.
 - viii. Vehicles involved in maintenance, delivery of goods & services and medical emergency.
 - ix. Hospitals, including private, persons visiting hospitals for medical emergency, Pharmaceutical and health related manufacturing units and their ancillaries together with transportation related activities.
 - x. Petrol Pumps, LPG gas, Oil agencies, their godowns and their transportation related activities.
 - xi. Telecom and internet services.
 - xii. Dhabas/ eateries on National Highways with the prior permission of SDM concerned.
 - xiii. Inter-district stage carriage passenger vehicles in transit. Any person with confirmed bus/train ticket of such a bus/train, who is essentially required to travel during curfew hours.
 - xiv. Accredited print and electronic media correspondents and persons and vehicles involved in newspaper supply chain.
 - xv. Workers performing mortuary funeral, cremation, burial, cemetery and related services including funeral homes, crematoriums, cemeteries and coffin makers.
2. In all indoor/ covered areas and open spaces including marriage places & banquet halls, for all social/ academic/ sports entertainment/ cultural/ political/ religious and other congregations.


50% of the capacity shall be allowed subject to adherence of the COVID-19 safety protocols and COVID appropriate behaviour. It shall be mandatory for the organizer to get the permission from the Sub-Divisional Magistrates concerned. The permission shall be obtained at least one week before the date of event/ function.

All the SDMs, Executive Magistrates, Police and local authorities of District Una are directed to ensure strict compliance of the above directions. Violation of the above orders will be a punishable offence under the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and all the SDMs, Executive Magistrates, DSPs and SHOs of the District Una and officers authorized by the Sub Divisional Magistrate will be authorized to initiate legal proceedings under Section 60 of Disaster Management Act, 2005.

Penal Provisions

Any person violating these measures and not following COVID appropriate behavior will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provision of Section 51-60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides entailing legal action under Section 188 of the IPC, and other legal provisions as applicable.


This order will come into effect immediately and shall remain in force till further orders.
