Guiding Terms of Reference (TOR)

For

Training of Mahila Mangal Dal/Yuva Mangal Dal and School Awareness Program

Uttarakhand has geographical area of 53,483 sq km; 93 percent of which is mountainous and 64 percent is under forest cover. 27th state of the Republic of India, Uttarakhand has two divisions; Garhwal and Kumaun. The state has 13 districts of which 07 (Pauri Garhwal, Tehri Garhwal, Chamoli, Haridwar, Dehradun, Uttarkashi, Rudraprayag) are in Garhwal while the remaining 06 (Almora, Bageshwar, Champawat, Nainital, Udham Singh Nagar, Pithoragarh) are in Kumaun. Geo – tectonic set up of the region together with its evolutionary history, geomorphology and meteorological characteristics make Uttarakhand prone to a number of natural hazards. Besides earthquakes the area is vulnerable to and frequently devastated by landslides, cloudbursts, flash floods, floods, avalanches, droughts, lightening, cold waves and hailstorms. Due to the ongoing tectonic movements the region has accumulated enormous strain that makes it susceptible to seismic tremors. The state falls in Zone IV and Zone V of Earthquake Zonation Map of India. Pithoragarh, Bageshwar, Chamoli and Rudraprayag districts together with some areas of Almora, Champawat, Tehri, Uttarkashi and Pauri district fall in Zone V while the remaining area falls in Zone IV. In the past the State has witnessed two major earthquakes (Uttarkashi 1991 and Chamoli 1999).

The marginal and deprived section of the society is always sufferers and is the most badly affected during disaster as it does not have resources to recover from social and economical losses caused by disaster. Awareness, training, capacity building and sensitization about the role of community in disaster situations are the key elements of disaster resilience that must be known to every section of the community. Enhancing capacities of the local community groups like Mahila Mangal Dal (MMD) and Yuva Mangal Dal (YMD) would definitely help in mitigating the losses due to disaster.

Registered community groups that include Mahila Mangal Dal (MMD) and Yuva Mangal Dal (YMD) exist throughout the state routinely undertake various community welfare programs these groups could be important stakeholders for community response in emergency situation. A total of 10,376 Yuva dals are registered in the state and by training the members of these groups a pool of first responders could be created throughout the state.

The concept of 'school safety' has evolved over the last couple of decades as the threat to the physical wellbeing of children has become more visible both globally and in the country.




“Comprehensive School Safety” has emerged as the leading concept to address the nexus between disaster risk and the need for education and child protection before, during and after emergencies. Culture of safe school needs to be promoted for which mass awareness programs in schools are required.

The role of NGOs is crucial in all phases of disaster management as they have grass root presence and can facilitate co-ordination between community and government.

In view of above District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA) Chamoli (Gopeshwar), is to engage NGOs working in the field of Disaster Management and is willing to undertake capacity building programs for the members of identified MMD and YMD of the district and organizing awareness programs in identified schools in the district.

Scope of work

1. Selected NGO would have to organize the training program for MMD, YMD and awareness programs for schools.
2. The training program is to be organized for community groups. It is therefore necessary that the training program be organized in Hindi. Knowledge of the local dialects (Garhwali and Kumaoni) would be an added advantage.
3. The training program shall be of 05 days duration and would have to be organized at Gram Panchayat and as per the broad outline and schedule given at **annexure 1**.
4. The participants would have to be provided certificate of successful completion of training. The format of the same would be provided by the DDMA.
5. Soft and hard copy of the training report would have to be prepared and submitted to DDMA after each training program after verification. Beside other things this should have complete details of the participants. Digital photographs, ID and contact details of all the participants would have to be submitted separately and same has to be uploaded on web site of USDMA.
6. Refreshment and lunch would be provided by NGO during training to MMD and YMD.
7. The participants would have to be provided stationary and reading material (reading material to be provided by DDMA).
8. Increasing knowledge and awareness on culture of safe schools by organizing awareness programs in schools (primary, junior and inter colleges) located in Gram Panchayat where training of MMD and YMD is being organized. Schedule of program given at **annexure 2**.
9. Refreshment would be provided by NGO during awareness program in schools as additional item along with MDM.



Interested NGOs should provide information demonstrating that they have relevant experience in disaster management related activities.

Short-listing Criteria

1. The applicant should be "Registered Legal Entity and should have proven track record of being operational for at least three years. (Attach relevant documents in support of the same.)
2. The NGO should have last three years audited balance sheet signed by authorized signatory of the organization.
3. The NGO should have working experience in the field of disaster management. (Attach relevant documents in support of the same).
4. The NGO should demonstrate that they have capacity of conducting training programs, particularly in the field of disaster management.
5. Average annual turnover for the previous three financial years ending on 31st March, 2017 should be equal to or greater than 05 lakh (Attach balance sheets and P&L accounts of last 3 years).
6. The applicant should not be under a declaration of ineligibility for corrupt and fraudulent practices or any other reason, whatsoever, or have not been blacklisted by the Government of India or any other government agency. (Submit declaration to this regard on your official letter head.)
7. All the documents must be signed and self-attested by authorized signatory.
8. Short note on the similar projects implemented by the consulting firm should also be attached.
9. Bio-data of the key experts with experience in the field of disaster management working full time for the firm should also be included.
10. The NGO should provide a brief write up on how it would be making the program more impactful.
