

**ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973**

Whereas it has been made aware to me by S.P Kaithal vide letter No. 12186/Sec. dated 03-04-2019 that there is apprehension of breach of peace & tranquility and likelihood of causing tension annoyance, obstructions or injury or risk or danger to human life and property & disturbance to public peace within the revenue limits of Kaithal District on account of Parliamentary General Elections, 2019 which is scheduled to be held on 12<sup>th</sup> May, 2019.

Whereas, it has been further made aware to me that possession of fire-arms and ammunition in the revenue limits of the Kaithal district, by the license holders of all categories in this behalf, is likely to cause obstructions in the maintenance of peace and tranquility and it has become necessary to get the fire-arms and the ammunition deposited in respective police stations/Arms & Ammunition Dealers.

AND Whereas I, **Dr. Priyanka Soni, I.A.S, District Magistrate, Kaithal** am satisfied that directions under section 144 Cr.P.C. are necessary to avoid danger to human life and property and disturbance of public peace, tranquility, riot and affray and also for the maintenance of law & order.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me under section 144 of the code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, **I, Dr. Priyanka Soni, I.A.S, District Magistrate, Kaithal** do hereby direct all the license holders under the Arms Act.1959, except licenses issued to National Banks/Private Banks of the district, to deposit their fire arms and ammunition in their respective police stations/Arms & Ammunition Dealer against proper receipts to be issued by S.H.O/Arms & Ammunition Dealer. The S.H.O/Arms & Ammunition Dealer concerned shall be duty bound to ensure safe custody of all the fire arms so deposited till the election process is over. The licensees can take back their fire arms from S.H.O/Arms & Ammunition Dealer concerned upon production of the receipts on any day after the completion of election process. However, this order shall not apply to Police personnel and other public servants on duty.

Since, the circumstances do not permit to serve notice to persons concerned, therefore, this order is being passed ex-parte & addressed to the public in general. This order shall be promulgated throughout the limits of Kaithal district for the information of public through electronic & print media and publicity van of information & Public Relations Department, Kaithal and also by affixing copies on notice boards in the District Courts/Sub Divisions/Tehsils/Sub Tehsils, all Police Stations, MCs, Zila Parishad, Panchayat Samitis etc.

In case of any violation of the aforesaid orders, person(s) found guilty shall liable to be prosecuted under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.
