

ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973

Whereas it has been made to appear to me that there is likelihood of causing tension annoyance obstruction or injury to person, danger to human life and property disturbance of public peace and tranquility within the revenue limits of the District Kaithal on account of the forthcoming Haryana Vidhan Sabha General Election 2019 which is to be held on 21st October, 2019 and Counting of Votes on 24th October, 2019.

Whereas, it has been further made to appear to me that possession of fire-arms and ammunition in the revenue limits of the District Kaithal, by the license holders of all categories in this behalf, is likely to cause obstruction in the maintenance of peace and tranquility and it has become necessary to get the fire-arms and ammunition deposited in respective police stations/Arms & Ammunition dealers.

And whereas **I, Dr. Priyanka Soni, I.A.S, District Magistrate, Kaithal** am satisfied that direction under section 144 Cr.P.C. are necessary to avoid danger to human life and property and disturbance of public tranquility, riot and affray and also for the maintenance of law and order.


Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of section 144 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, **I, Dr. Priyanka Soni, I.A.S, District Magistrate, Kaithal** do hereby direct all the license Holders under Arm Act, 1959, except license issued to National Bank/private Banks of the District, Kaithal, to deposit their fire-arms and ammunition in their respective police stations/Arms & Ammunition dealers by 28th September, 2019 against proper receipts to be issued by S.H.O. /Arms & Ammunition dealer. The S.H.O. /Arms & Ammunition dealer concerned shall be duty bound to ensure safe custody of all the fire arms so deposited till completion of election process is over. The license Holders can take their fire-arms back from S.H.O. /Arms & Ammunition dealer concerned upon production of the receipt on any day after election process is over. However, this order shall not be applicable to the police personnel and other public servants on the duty.

Since, the circumstances do not permit to serve notice to persons concerned, therefore, this order is being passed ex-parte and addressed to the public in general. This order shall be promulgated throughout the limits of Kaithal district for the information of public through electronic & print media and publicity van in Information and Public Relation Department, Kaithal and also by affixing copies on notice boards in the District Courts/Sub Divisions/Tehsils/Sub Tehsils, all Police Stations, Municipal Committees, Zila Parishad, Panchayat Samitis etc.

In case of any violation of the aforesaid orders, person(s) found guilty shall liable to be prosecuted under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1861.
