

ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973

Whereas, it has been made to appear to me that there is likelihood of causing tension, annoyance, obstruction or injury to person, danger to human life and property, disturbance of public peace and tranquility within the area of Kaithal District by some agitators, miscreants, and anti-social elements in view of Ayodhya land dispute decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

And whereas, it has been made to appear to me that the Carrying of any weapons of offence like Arms, Swords, Lathis, Bhallas, Kulharis, Jallies, Gandasis, Knives, Cycle Chains and other articles capable of causing injury and used as weapons of offence is likely to cause obstruction in the maintenance of public peace and tranquility in the area of District Kaithal, it has become necessary to prohibit carrying of above such weapons of offences and other article capable of being used as weapons of offence (except Sheathed Kirpan) in the area of District Kaithal.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me under section 144 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, **I, Rahul Hooda, I.A.S, Additional District Magistrate, Kaithal** do hereby prohibit the assembly of five or more persons at public place, without permission from District Magistrate and as a measure of emergency the carrying of any weapons like Arms, Swords, Lathis, Barchhas, Kulharis, Jellies, Gandasis, Knives and any other weapons (except Sheathed Kirpan used as a genuine religious symbol of Sikhs) in the area of District Kaithal with immediate effect.

This order shall not apply to the Police and other public servants on duty. In view of emergant situation & shortage of time, this order is passed ex-party and is being addressed to the public in general.

This order shall be promulgated in the area of District Kaithal by beat of drum & announcement through the publicity van of Public Relation Department and Publication in Newspapers, by fixation of the copies of this order on Notice Board of Tehsils, Blocks, Municipal Committee Offices, Police Stations, Bus Stands and other public places.

The violation of this order is punishable under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.
