

ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973

Whereas it has been brought to my notice by the Central Board of Secondary Education New Delhi vide office letter No.CBSE/SECRET/2020/833-54 dated 23.01.2020. In view of that, it has been made to appear to me that there is likelihood of causing tension, annoyance and obstruction or injury to person, danger to human life and property, disturbance of public peace and tranquility within the limit of examination centers for C.B.S.E. exam class 10th and 12th to be held from 15-02-2020 and continue till 30-03-2020 from 10:00AM to 01:30 P.M in various educational institutions Distt. Kaithal being conducted by the Central Board of School Education, Shiksha Kendra, Delhi.

Whereas it has been made to appear to me that the gathering of the five or more person is likely to cause obstruction in the maintenance of peace and tranquility within the area of about 200 meters around the Examinations centers in the Kaithal District (List attached).

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of Section 144 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. **I, Sujan Singh, I.A.S., District Magistrate, Kaithal** do hereby prohibit the gathering of the five or more person in the area of 200 meters around the Examination centers in Kaithal District during the period on 15.02.2020 to 30.03.2020 Photo-stat business is banned only during the Examination during 10:00 AM to 01:30 PM. The Candidate should not carry any mobile phone, pager, electronic or communication device etc in the premises/boundary wall of examination centers.

This order shall not apply to the Police and other public servants on duty.

In view of the emergent situation of shortage of time, this order is being passed ex-parte and is being addressed to the public in general.

This order shall be promulgated within the limits of Examination centers in Kaithal District by beat of drum, by announcement, through the publicity Van of public Relation Department, by fixing of the copies of this order on Notice Boards of the Examination centers, Sub Divisional and Tehsil Courts and public places as well as the Police Stations.

For the violation of the aforesaid order, if any person found guilty, he will be liable for punishment under section, 188 of the Indian Penal Code.
