

ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973

Whereas it has been made to appear to me that there is a likelihood of disturbance of public peace and tranquility on account of Noval Corona Virus (nCOVID-19)

And whereas, I, am satisfied that immediate measures are needed to be taken for prevention of such danger to human health and safety of general public, hence there is apprehension of spread of nCOVID-19 in case of public gathering.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of section 144 of code of Criminal procedure, 1973. **I, Sujan Singh, I.A.S, District Magistrate Kaithal** do hereby prohibit the gathering of five or more then five person in public places in the jurisdiction of District Kaithal.

Even in case the assembly is less than twenty persons, it will be ensured that social distancing norms circulated by the Government of India in the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) will be followed, However, movement of people in public transport or in any other mode of transport especially in the eventuality of medical emergencies will be exempted from this order.

This order shall not apply to the Police/Military/Para Military Forces and other Public servants on duty.

This Order shall come into force with immediate effect and shall remain in force till **14-04-2020** if not revoked earlier.

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable u/s 188 of Indian Penal Code. Superintendent of Police, Kaithal shall be responsible for implementation of this order.

In view of requirement of the situation which has become emergent, this order is being passed ex-parte as being addressed to the public in general.

This order shall be promulgated in area of Kaithal district by beat of drum, by announcement through the publicity van of Public Relation Department and by affixing of the copies of this order on the notice boards of District Courts/ Sub Divisions/Tehsil Courts/Police Stations and through print and electronic media.

The Superintendnet of Police Kaithal and Sub Divisional Magistrates in their respective areas shall be responsible for enforcement of the above prohibitory orders in letter and spirit.
