OFFICE OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR: DRDA, IMPHAL-EAST DISTRICT.

Proceedings of the District Development Co-ordination and Monitoring Committee Meeting held on 19th November, 2017 at Panchayat Bhavan, Porompat, Imphal East, District under the Chairmanship of Dr. Thokchom Meinya, Honb'le MP Lok Sabha (Inner) Manipur at 11:30 am with the members present as in Annexure.

At the outset of the meeting, Dr. Thokchom Meinya, Honb'le MP Lok Sabha (Inner), Manipur welcomed the members present and initiated the meeting and Smt. Th. Chitra Devi, Deputy Commissioner, Imphal East District deliberated on the business session of the meeting with a PowerPoint (ppt) presentation on the various programmes/ schemes taken up under different Departments.

Observations placed in the meeting:

IWMP:

1. Project Officer, IWMP expressed the need for co-operation of all the related Departments functioning in the district, so that the programme could be implemented smoothly and completed within the scheduled timeline.

Mid Day Meal Programme:

2. It was observed in the meeting that the wages of the cooks have not been released from the state Government from January, 2017 till date.
3. Honb'le MP Dr. T. Meinya observed that there is uneven distribution of food grains in Schools under Mid Day Meal programme. He advised especially the ZEO to look into this issue and work out an appropriate mechanism to wipe out the existing anomalies.

SSA

4. DPM, Imphal East District gave a powerpoint (ppt) on the implementation of SSA in the District.
5. ZEO expressed that as per the instruction, the school authority should provide two sets of uniform for Rs. 400 which is practically difficult to arrange. He also requested to enhance the amount of uniform.
6. DPM also raised the issue that the fund should be released in time with sufficient amount so that the scheme can be implemented efficiently and successfully.
7. Honb'le MP Dr. T. Meinya also observed that ZEO, Imphal East should submit a report of the drop out students to the Administrative Department.

SAGY

8. DC, Imphal East expressed the need of expediting the process of implementation of SAGY in Pukhao GP and also requested all the DLOs to submit the DPRs for finalization of the VDP for Pukhao Model GP under SAGY at the earliest

PMFBY (Prime Minister Fasal Bima Yojana)

9. After having seen the ppt. of District Agriculture Officer, Honb'le MP Dr. T. Meinya observed the need for simplifying the process of reporting to the Dept. by allowing the farmers to report only at the level of the Extension Officer. This will help in expediting the process to make avail of the benefit of the Scheme
10. Honb'le MP also observed the need for organising awareness programme of the Scheme at the Gram Panchayat Level so that every farmer may be aware of the scheme for which the Dept. should claim the fund in time to the Govt.

PMGSY

11. AE, PMGSY, Imphal East gave a ppt.on the implementation of the Scheme in the District and noted that Imphal East is the first District to start geo-tagging in the State.
12. Honb'le MP Dr. T. Meinya observed that after the completion of the construction of roads, the implementing agency is responsible for maintenance of the roads for 5 years. He stated that the department should take care of this timely maintenance.
13. Honb'le MP also observed that PMGSY is one of the very important useful schemes for the development of a district. He also expressed the need of implementing such scheme well right from the grass root level in the field to the administrative level.

PMAY (G)

14. DC, Imphal East gave a powerpoint (ppt) on the status of implementation of PMAY (G) Scheme in Imphal East District. She stated that PMAY (G) is the re-structured scheme of IAY scheme so that the limitations of the IAY could be overcome. PMAY (G) sanctioned in the FY 2016-17 has been implemented only in the current FY 2017-18. In respect of the District, 90% of the beneficiaries has been sanctioned for 3(three) CD Blocks viz. Imphal East-I,II & Jiribam CD Block.

MGNREGS

15. DC, Imphal East gave a brief account of the MGNREGS Scheme and stated that a total of 345440 lakh persondays have been generated providing an average of 7days to every household in the district so far.

MSRLM

16. Honb'le MP Dr. T. Meinya observed that bank loan sanctioned to the Self Help Groups still now is too low and this needs to be monitored. Regarding the matter the Bank Manager clarified that the bank is under process of sanctioning loans to such Self Help Groups and loans will be given very soon.

NHM

17. Chief Medical Officer, Imphal East raised the issues of lack of specialist Doctors, untimely release of fund from the State and low staff salary of the contract staff despite of the nature of duties and services rendered by them.
18. Honb'le MP advised the concerned authority that such type of huge difference of pay between the regular and contract staff should be appraised to the Government.

PMGSY

19. EE, PMGSY, Imphal East gave a powerpoint (ppt) on the implementation of the scheme and raised the issue of the delay in the release of fund. He also stated that the fund released recently is the fund for the FY 2016-17 released during the FY, 2017-18.
20. Honb'le MP Dr. T. Meinya made a general remark to the Govt. for timely release of fund for all the schemes.

DDUGJY (NRLM)

21. It is implemented in 3 districts viz. Imphal East, Imphal West and Thoubal only and the funding pattern is 1st Installment 10%, 2nd Installment 20% and 3rd and final instalment is 70%.

Digital India Land Records (NLRMP)

22. DIO, Imphal East gave a powerpoint on the status of the implementation of the scheme.

NSAP (Social Welfare)

23. DSWO kept a brief report of the various schemes under the Dept. Honb'le MP observed that the old aged persons who are eligible for the scheme but left out in the data should be included in the scheme. Therefore, the list of all such left outs should be prepared at the earliest and should be included in the list so that they may also enjoy the benefit of the same. He also expressed the need of revision of the list of beneficiaries.
24. Honb'le MP also made a general observation that all women should keep her own surname even after marriage to avoid confusions.

The meeting after a detailed discussion unanimously resolved the following resolutions.

1. It is resolved in the meeting that ZEO, Imphal East should submit a report of the drop out students to the Administrative Department.
2. It is also resolved in the meeting that in order to expedite the process for availing benefits to the deserving farmers under the Scheme, the farmers should be allowed to report only at the level of the Extension Officer and the Dept. should organise awareness programme at the Gram Panchayat level at the earliest.
3. It is also resolved in the meeting for revision of the list of beneficiaries under the NSAP Schemes.
