Proceedings of the District Development Co-ordination and Monitoring Committee Meeting held on 23rd November, 2018 at Panchayat Bhavan, Porompat, Imphal East, District under the Chairmanship of Dr. Thokchom Meinya, Honb'le MP (Lok Sabha) Inner Manipur Parliamentary Constituency at 10:00 am with the members present as in annexure.

At the outset of the meeting, Dr. Thokchom Meinya, Honb'le MP Lok Sabha (Inner), Manipur Parliamentary Constituency welcomed the members present and initiated the meeting and Smt. Th. Chitra Devi, Deputy Commissioner, Imphal East District also extended welcome to all the members present and deliberated on the business session of the meeting. The meeting then followed by an oath taking ceremony as a part of Quami Ekta Celebration by hon'ble MP, Dr. Thokchom Meinya.

Observations of the meeting:

Agriculture:

1. District Agriculture Officer, Imphal East gave a powerpoint presentation (PPT) on the Physical and Financial performance of various schemes taken up under the Dept.
2. Dr. Thokchom Meinya, Honb'le MP Lok Sabha (Inner), Manipur Parliamentary Constituency observed that most of the common people are unaware of the schemes under Agriculture Dept. Therefore, more focus should be on awareness /advertisements of schemes so that the common people, especially the farmers may be aware of the schemes and may be able to take maximum benefits of the schemes.

NIHM

3. District Family Welfare Officer, Imphal East gave a powerpoint presentation (PPT) on various activities taken up under the Dept/schemes.
4. Honb'le MP observed in the meeting that most of the activities taken up under the schemes are based on the data / reports from the ASHAs, he, therefore expressed the need for ensuring that the payments/ incentives of the ASHAs should be paid in time as an encouraging/ motivative measures for the ASHAs.

Mid Day Meal Programme (Education Dept.)

5. ZEO, Imphal East gave a powerpoint presentation (PPT) on the schemes under the Dept. He raised up the issue of low honorarium of the cooks.
6. Honb'le MP observed the need for providing at least one school in every village so that every child may be able to get basic minimum education. He also advised the authority to submit proposals to the Govt.

SSA (Education)

7. DPO, Imphal East District gave a powerpoint on the implementation of SSA in the District.
8. Honb'le MP Dr. T. Meinya also observed the need for strengthening the conditions of the Govt. schools of the State in order to enable students from various sections of the society to receive good educations and healthy academic atmosphere.

PMEGP (DIC)

9. District General Manager, Imphal East gave a PowerPoint presentation (PPT) on the scheme and highlighted on the status of the works taken up under the Schemes.

Horticulture:

10. District horticulture officer gave a PowerPoint presentation (PPT) on the schemes under Horticulture Dept.

PHED:

11. EE, PHED gave a Powerpoint presentation (PPT) on various Schemes taken up under the Dept. like SBM, NLCMR, NESIDS, NEC, etc. He pointed out the importance and requirement of timely release of fund by the State Finance Dept. for timely completion of the work programme implemented under various Schemes.

DRDA:

12. The concerned Officials of various Schemes under DRDA, Imphal East gave PowerPoint (PPT) of various schemes under DRDA like SAGY, MGNREGS, PMAY(G), IWMP etc and discussed the issues faced by the District in the implementation of the Schemes.
13. Honb'le MP Dr. T. Meinya expressed the need for more co-operation and contribution from the DLOs of Imphal East District in the implementation of the approved work programme under VDP in respect of Model GPs under SAGY.

NSAP (Social Welfare)

14. DSWO kept a brief report of the various schemes under the Dept. Hon'ble MP observed that all the old aged persons who are eligible for the scheme should not be left out and also ensure that their pensions are distributed in time.

The meeting after a detailed discussion unanimously resolved the following resolutions:

1. It is resolved in the meeting that Agriculture Dept. should focus on the training and advertisements of the schemes under the Dept. so that the farmers may be aware of the various Schemes and take maximum benefits from the said schemes.
2. It is also resolved in the meeting that in order to improve the Social and economic status of the State, every child needs to get at least minimum education for which strengthening the conditions of the Govt. schools is a must. Accordingly, a concrete proposal for providing at least one school in every village shall be submitted to the concerned Administrative Dept.
3. It is also resolved in the meeting that all the DLOs should work/co-ordinate with the concerned authority and focus on SAGY scheme as the Scheme is being implemented under certain targets and stipulated timeline which has to be completed by 2019.
