

**IN THE COURT OF THE DISTRICT MAGISTRATE, IMPHAL EAST DISTRICT,**

**CRIL. MISC CASE NO. 2 OF 2019.**

**ORDERS UNDER SECTION 144 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE**

Porompat, the 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2019.

Whereas, there is an apprehension of serious breach of peace, disturbance to public tranquility and grave danger to human lives and properties in the area which is described in the schedule given below due to the situation arising out of the intense agitation launched by various Civil Society Organisations (CSOs) numbering more than 165 under the banner of Manipur People against Citizenship Amendment Bill, 2016 (MANPAC) and People Alliance Manipur (PAM) against the passing of the Citizenship Amendment Bill, 2016 in the Lok Sabha;

AND Whereas, I have also received information from the Superintendent of Police, Imphal East that more intensified agitation is likely to be from tomorrow, the 12<sup>th</sup> February, 2019 and there is every likelihood of causing serious breach of peace, leading to loss of lives and public properties within the scheduled area of Imphal East District. Further, involvement of various organisations in the agitation may vitiate further law and order situation. Hence, **prohibitory orders** under Section 144 Cr.P.C, 1973 is considered necessary in the public interest;

AND Whereas, it has become expedient to issue prohibitory orders for prevention of breach of peace, disturbance to public tranquility and grave danger to human lives and properties;

Now, therefore, **I, Th. Chitra Devi**, District Magistrate, Imphal East District, Manipur do hereby promulgate the prohibitory orders under Section 144 Cr.P.C., 1973, and order that the general public shall remain indoors during the **period from intervening midnight of 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> February, 2019 until further Orders** in the schedule of area given below:


**SCHEDULE OF AREA**

**The whole area under Imphal East District, Manipur**

Whereas, there is emergency and circumstances do not permit the serving in due time of a notice upon the public, this Orders is passed ex-parte under Section 144 Cr.P.C, 1973 and is directed to the public in general;

This Orders shall not apply to the agencies of the Govt. involved in the enforcement of law and order and the maintenance of essential services.
