ORDERS
(UNDER SECTION 144 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE)
Porompat, the 12th October, 2021

Whereas, report has been received from the Superintendent of Police, Imphal East District vide letter No. C-6/4/SP-IE/2021 dated, 11th October, 2021 and Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Keirao Bitra vide letter no.1/91/SDO/KBT/Misc/II dated 12th October 2021 that a violent clash has erupted on 11.09.2021 at about 10.30 am at Yairipok Yambem between the supporters of two intending candidates of Andro Assembly constituency. Aftermath of the said incident, 3 (three) persons have been injured and the prevailing situation of the area has become volatile.

Whereas, such incident may cause serious breach of peace & disturbances of the public tranquillity and thereby, endanger human lives and properties in the area described by the schedule below; and

Whereas, such disturbance of the public tranquillity, breach of peace, and endangerment of human life and property are sought to be prevent; and

Whereas, it is considered that restriction on (i) assembly of 5 or more persons which is likely to turn unlawful and, (ii) prohibition on carrying of firearms, sticks, stones, weapons or objects of any description which can be used as offensive weapons would be effective in preventing such disturbances as described above; and

Whereas, it has therefore become expedient to issue a prohibitory order with the objective of preventing a breach of peace, disturbance of public tranquillities and endangerment of human life and property; and

Whereas, I consider this as a fit case for issuing prohibitory orders under Section 144 of CrPC 1973 in keeping with the above objective;

Now, therefore, I, **Khumanthem Diana Devi, IAS**, District Magistrate, Imphal East District, Manipur, in exercise of the powers conferred under sub-section 2 of Section 144 of Cr. P. C., 1973, do hereby prohibit, **for a period of two months with effect from 0600 hours of 12.10.2021**, the following activities in the area described by the schedule below:

- (i) **the assembly of 5 or more persons which is likely to turn unlawful; and**
- (ii) **the carrying of firearms, sticks, stones, weapons or objects of any description which can be used as offensive weapons;**

As there is emergency and the circumstances do not permit the serving of a due notice upon whom this order is directed, this order is passed ex-parte.

This order shall not apply to the government agencies or functionaries involved in the enforcement of law and order.


Copies of this order shall be pasted on the notice boards of the District Magistrate, Imphal East District, the Superintendent of Police, Imphal East District, Manipur. Wide publicity thereof in the scheduled area shall also be caused by the Officer-in-charge of the concerned police station having jurisdiction over the said area.
