Today's update:

3 New COVID-19 Positive cases have been reported in Chitradurga (P-751, P-752 and P-753) and they are under treatment.

1. **12 Dedicated Fever Clinics** have been established in the District, 3 in Chitradurga, 2 each at Molakalmuru, Hiriya, Challakere taluks and 1 in Holalkere taluk respectively. So far **1242** people have been screened till date.
2. **10 COVID Care Centers** have been established in the District, 3 in Chitradurga, 2 each at Molakalmuru, Challakere taluks and 1 in each Holalkere, Hosadurga and Hiriya taluks respectively with a view to accommodate people who have been advised Facility/Institutional Quarantine.
3. **6 Dedicated COVID Health Centers** have been identified in the District, 1 (CHCs) in each Taluks to treat mild cases.
4. **2 Dedicated COVID Hospitals** have been identified. District Hospital and BMCRCCH, (Private Medical College) Chitradurga for isolation and treatment of Severe confirmed cases.
5. **Psychiatrist** with supporting team from Mental Health Care was on duty for providing psycho-social support to the suspected /confirmed cases at the isolation and quarantine centers.
6. **6 Relief Camps/Centers** for 256 migratory populations have been identified in all taluks and all inmates have been screened and giving food.
