Subject: Relaxations due to unlock in District Samba – regarding COVID-19.

Whereas, order No. DMS/JC/20-21/COVID-19/322-332, dated: 29-07-2020, is expiring on 04-08-2020 at 5 AM. Therefore, it has been decided to give relaxation in the ongoing lockdown till further orders.

- A. Therefore, it is hereby ordered that all the shops in the District shall remain open daily from 9 AM to 5 PM w.e.f. 04-08-2020 onwards except Dhabas, Restaurants, Sweet shops. All types of eateries will continue to remain closed;
- B. And areas declared as Red Zones / Containment Zones will remain under the complete lockdown and no relaxation will be applicable to such areas.
- C. Medical Shops, Testing Laboratories, Doctor Clinics, Ayurvedic shops, Pansari shops and Homeopathy shops falling under the jurisdiction of District Samba shall remain open from 9 AM to 8 PM daily till further orders.


However, all the shops shall observe Sunday as Holiday except the shops mentioned at S.No. C.

Further, no parking will be allowed in the Markets or in front of shops whether vehicles belong to shopkeepers or customers.

All the shopkeepers will follow the following conditions strictly:-

- a. The shopkeepers will strictly follow the above given schedule and timings.
- b. Only 50% of the staff of the shops will remain present in the shop at any given time.
- c. All the shopkeepers shall mandatorily wear the face masks.
- d. The shopkeepers will have to provide sanitizers / soap to staff as well as customers.
- e. It is mandatory for all the shopkeepers to Download Arogya Setu Mobile App in their mobiles.
- f. A fine as per the Government order will be imposed against the violators for not wearing the face mask and also for the maintenance of social distancing.

Anybody found violating these norms will be dealt with firmly.
