2. This office letter No.193/TSSGDCFL/T2/2017,dated: 18.09.2019.
3. Instructions from the Government during review meeting held on 03.10.2019.

In continuation of the SRDP implementation guidelines issued vide reference 2nd cited and as per the instructions of the Government, vide reference 3rd cited, I invite the attention of the District Veterinary & Animal Husbandry Officers of all Districts (except Hyderabad) to follow the Scheme implementation guidelines earlier issued strictly duly following the below mentioned items also.

1. It is requested to take the photograph of the Beneficiary along with Sheep unit (20 + 1) at the procurement place and upload in the app immediately at the procurement place itself.
2. It is also informed that maximum grounding of Sheep Units for each District should not exceed (125 Units) per month depending upon the balance/pending D.D's available in the District.
3. All the District Veterinary & Animal Husbandry Officers are requested to constitute Mandal procurement committees, with the concerned Veterinary Assistant Surgeon, Mandal Parishad Development Officer/his representative and Thasildar/his representative invariably of the concerned Mandal with due approval of the Collector & District Magistrate of that District. The (3)

member Mandal committee shall proceed for procurement along with Beneficiary with the due approval of Collector for grounding of Sheep units.

4. Sheep Units must be procured/purchased with the consent of the beneficiary only.
5. Photograph must be taken at unloading point along with unit & Beneficiary in the presence of village elders, Viz concerned Sarpanch of the village, President of PSBCS etc,. Acknowledgement shall be obtained immediately after receipt of unit from the Beneficiary and upload the photo in the App.
6. GPS and Check post system must be followed and concerned District Veterinary & Animal Husbandry Officers are requested to deploy the staff at Check posts without fail.

All the District Veterinary & Animal Husbandry Officers are requested to follow the above instructions/guidelines scrupulously.

Any deviation/complaints will be viewed seriously and action will be initiated against the erring officials.
