Subject: Classification of districts in Jammu & Kashmir as RED, ORANGE and GREEN for the purpose of implementing the lockdown, w.e.f. 04.05.2020


Government Order No. 48 – JK (DMRRR) of 2020.
Dated: 03.05.2020

- 1) Whereas, the Government of India vide its Order No.40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 1.5.2020, has issued guidelines for the classification of Districts as Red, Orange or Green for the purpose of permitting certain activities during the on-going COVID-19 lockdown; and,
- 2) Whereas, States and UTs are allowed to consider inclusion of additional districts in Red or Orange categories without diluting the existing categorization based on risk assessment; and,
- 3) Whereas, a detailed review was conducted on the basis of
 - a. an overall assessment of the situation pertaining to the spread of COVID-19 in Jammu and Kashmir,
 - b. the trend in new cases as well as the possibility of an imminent spread/ spike in new cases in view of the expected movement of stranded persons to Jammu and Kashmir in the next two weeks, and
 - c. the risk perception of the Health department vis-a-vis each district;
- 4) Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 24 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the undersigned, in his capacity as the Chairperson of the State Executive Committee, hereby orders that the classification of districts into Red, Orange and Green categories for Jammu & Kashmir will be as under:

S.No.	Category	Name of the district(s)
1.	RED	1) All 10 districts of Kashmir province 2) Jammu, Kathua and Samba districts of Jammu Province.
2.	ORANGE	Reasi, Udhampur, Ramban and Rajouri.
3.	GREEN	Doda, Kishtwar and Poonch.

- 5) This categorization of districts into Red, Orange and Green will be followed for the purposes of implementation of permitted activities in the respective districts, as per a separate order, to be issued by the State Executive Committee (SEC).
- 6) This classification of districts will be reviewed periodically and any further modifications will be made by the Government of Jammu & Kashmir keeping in view any further developments or instructions from MoHFW/ MHA, Govt. of India.
