Sub: COVID-19 Management- Restrictions thereof



ORDER

Whereas, COVID-19 has been declared as global pandemic by World Health Organization (WHO) affecting several Countries of the world including India;

Whereas, several advisories have been issued by the Health Authorities of Government of India, to prevent the spread of COVID-19 pandemic and break the transmission chain of the virus;

Whereas the Novel Corona Virus (Covid-19) has an alarming rate of spread and is considered highly contagious thereby necessitating the enforcement of certain restrictions for maintaining Social Distancing among the masses in order to control the spread of the virus in the District;

Now, therefore in view of the above mentioned facts and in the interest of safety and well being of general public at large, I Nazim Zai Khan, KAS District Magistrate Ramban in exercise of the powers vested in me under Section 144 Cr.P.C, Section 34 of National Disaster Management Act, 2005 and in accordance with Section 2 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 do hereby order to impose following restrictions within the territorial limits of District Ramban with immediate effect:

1. No person shall venture out of his home and shall leave their home only in case of urgency. However, in no case shall more than four or more persons assemble at any public place in the towns/villages of the District.
2. All establishments and activities in District Ramban shall be restricted in accordance with the Provisions of SOP notified vide GO No. 73-JK(DMRRR) of 2020 and GO No. 74-JK (DMRRR) of 2020 dated 04.08.2020 and will be regulated through the means of Passes issued from this Office wherever found necessary.
3. No movement across Mohallas/Town shall be allowed for purchase of essential commodities and all have to endeavour for getting essential commodities from the nearby shops in their respective locality/Mohalla while strictly adhering to social distancing norms.
4. Public/Private movement, assembly, gathering or procession of any nature including religious, social, political, sports or ritualistic involving three or more than three persons shall only be allowed on the basis of permissions granted by this Office.
5. No public or private transport shall ply in the District except goods vehicle carrying essential items with proper permits/passos issued by this office.

6. Night Curfew from 10.00pm to 5.00am daily, already imposed vide Order Number DCR/Covid/19/2389-2406 dated 04.07.2020 shall continue to be in force till further orders.
7. Maintaining Social Distancing norms for Covid-19 and Wearing of Facial Masks in Public shall be mandatory in District Ramban and any violations will invite penalties as Ordered Vide this Office Order No. DCR/Covid-19/2759-70 dated 25.07.2020.
8. Government vehicles, ambulances and Government staff involved in the efforts against COVID-19 and staff of essential emergency services and who have been issued passes by the Competent Authority shall be allowed to move as per norms.
9. Police or Paramilitary persons or any other Government Servants on official duties for management of essential services with proper ID/Passes shall also be allowed to move unrestricted.

This order shall remain in-force with effect from 11.08.2020 till further orders.

In view of the emergent nature of the order, it is not possible to serve it individually and is addressed to the public of Ramban District in general. It shall be circulated in print, electronic and social media and through the medium of loud speakers for information of all concerned. Any violation of this order shall invite action under Indian Penal Code/Disaster Management Act, 2005 and Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897.
