Sub: Measures to prevent spread of Coronavirus - Imposition of restrictions under Section 144 Cr.P.C in the District thereof.

ORDER

Whereas, necessary precautions regarding prevention and control of Coronavirus (COVID-19) infection have already been undertaken by the District Administration in coordination with Police and Health Departments; and

Whereas, COVID-19 has pattern of transmission at rapid rate, in case prescribed prevention protocols, including mass gathering and unnecessary movement etc, are not strictly followed; and

Whereas, following issue of advisories by the Health authorities to prevent the spread of COVID-19 pandemic and break the transmission chain of the virus in the district, it has become necessary to enforce certain restrictions.

Now, therefore in view of the above-mentioned facts and in the interest of safety and well-being of the general public at large, **I, Mussarat Islam, KAS, District Magistrate and Chairperson, District Disaster Management Authority, Ramban**, in exercise of the powers vested in me under Section 144 Cr.P.C, Section 34 of National Disaster Management Act, 2005 and in accordance with Section 2 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, do hereby impose complete ban on movement of individuals for all non-essential activities from 8.00 pm on 24.04.2021 (Saturday) to 6.00 am on 26.04.2021 (Monday) in the territorial jurisdiction of District Ramban. However, essential/ emergency services/ movement/ work and scheduled marriages up to permissible gathering norms shall remain exempted, subject to production of wedding cards/ ID cards etc.

Furthermore, in continuation to the Government Order No.21-JK(DMRRR) of 2021, dated 18.04.2021, the Technical Training Institutions falling under the Department of Skill Development/ Technical Education in the territorial jurisdiction of District Ramban shall remain closed on campus/ in person education till 15.05.2021. Online education shall be the mode of teaching.

Besides, during the closure of educational institutions (schools/ colleges/ technical education institutions), attendance of the staff in person shall be restricted to 50% only. Heads of the Institutions shall devise roster to ensure implementation of this order.

The gathering limit as ordered vide earlier Government Order No.21-JK (DMRRR) of 2021, dated 18.04.2021, shall continue to remain in force.


Superintendent of Police, Ramban, shall ensure overall enforcement of the above orders in letter & spirit.

Any violation of this order shall invite action under Indian Penal Code/ Disaster Management Act, 2005 and Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897.
