Botad Taluka

Botad Taluka of Bhavnagar district (Now Botad Taluka is part of newly created Botad District) has **total population of 286,618** as per the Census 2011. Out of which 147,749 are males while 138,869 are females. In 2011 there were total 53,495 families residing in Botad Taluka.

The **Average Sex Ratio of Botad Taluka is 940.**

Gadhada Taluka

Gadhada Taluka of Bhavnagar district (Now Gadhada Taluka is part of newly created Botad District) has **total population of 200,475** as per the Census 2011. Out of which 102,328 are males while 98,147 are females. In 2011 there were total 36,992 families residing in Gadhada Taluka.

The **Average Sex Ratio of Gadhada Taluka is 959.**

Barwala Taluka

Barwala Taluka of Ahmadabad district (Now Barwala Taluka is a part of newly created Botad District) has **total population of 75,986** as per the Census 2011. Out of which 39,440 are males while 36,546 are females. In 2011 there were total 13,615 families residing in Barwala Taluka.

The **Average Sex Ratio of Barwala Taluka is 927.**

Ranpur Taluka

Ranpur Taluka of Ahmadabad district (Now Ranpur Taluka is a part of newly created Botad District) has **total population of 92,926** as per the Census 2011. Out of which 47,717 are males while 45,209 are females. In 2011 there were total 17,277 families residing in Ranpur Taluka.
