



Assembly Constituencies namely 1. 185 – Uttarpa, 2. 186 – Sreerampur, 3. 187 – Champdani, 4. 188 – Singur, 5. 189 – Chandannagar, 6. 190 – Chunchura, 7. 191 - Balagarh (SC), 8. 192 – Pandua, 9. 193 – Saptagram, 10. 194 - Chanditala under Hooghly District for maintaining Law & Order during 48 hours before close of poll with reference to the Notification No. ECI/PN/16/2021 DT. 26th February, 2021 of the Election Commission of India, New Delhi.

1/ 07/04/2021	<p>Whereas, it transpires from the Notification No. ECI/PN/16/2021 Dt. 26th February, 2021 of the Election Commission of India, New Delhi, that General Election to the West Bengal Legislative Assembly, 2021 in the district of Hooghly would be held on 10/04/2021 within the entire area comprising 10 (Ten) nos. Assembly Constituencies namely 1. 185 – Uttarpa, 2. 186 – Sreerampur, 3. 187 – Champdani, 4. 188 – Singur, 5. 189 – Chandannagar, 6. 190 – Chunchura, 7. 191 - Balagarh (SC), 8. 192 – Pandua, 9. 193 – Saptagram, 10. 194 - Chanditala under the jurisdiction of Hooghly District.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">AND</p> <p>Whereas, Polling will be held in 3586 nos. of Polling Stations in 10 (Ten) nos. Assembly Constituencies namely 1. 185 – Uttarpa, 2. 186 – Sreerampur, 3. 187 – Champdani, 4. 188 – Singur, 5. 189 – Chandannagar, 6. 190 – Chunchura, 7. 191 - Balagarh (SC), 8. 192 – Pandua, 9. 193 – Saptagram, 10. 194 - Chanditala under the jurisdiction of Hooghly District.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">AND</p> <p>Whereas, it appears from the order that the campaigning during the period of last 48 hours before the close of poll that is from 6:30 PM on 08/04/2021 for above-mentioned 10 (Ten) nos. of Assembly Constituencies for the 4th Phase of Election is prohibited. There would be a ban of campaigning for the last 48 hours before the schedule hour of closure of poll.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">AND</p> <p>Whereas, on loudspeakers fitted on vehicles of any kind or any other manner whatsoever shall be permitted to be used during the said period of 48 hours ending with area fixed for conclusion of the poll in any polling area under the entire area comprising 10 (Ten) nos above-mentined Assembly Constituencies in the District of Hooghly.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">AND</p> <p>Whereas, it appears that no person shall be allowed to either carry or use cellular Phone, Cordless Phone, Wireless Sets etc. in the periphery of 100 Meters radius of the polling stations or within the polling booth. Restrictions, however do not apply to the Officer-in-Charge of law and order and Security personnel put on duty near the polling Booth and may be using any of such instruments in the course of discharge of their official duties. Similarly these instructions are not applicable to the Observers appointed by the Commission and presiding officers of polling duties and officers drafted for polling duties.</p>

Whereas, no Arms should be carried inside the polling stations, no unauthorized persons should be present inside the polling station at any time during the poll.

AND

Whereas, I am satisfied that there is every reason to believe that unknown miscreants and disgruntled persons may attempt to create disorder and trouble outside the polling stations and thereby may cause breach of peace of public tranquillity. There is sufficient ground for proceeding for which immediate prevention is required.

Therefore, I, Dr. P. Deepap Priya, IAS, District Magistrate, Hooghly, in exercise of the power conferred upon me by section 144(2) of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, do hereby prohibit the following in the entire area comprising 10 (Ten) nos. Assembly Constituencies namely 1. 185 – Uttarpara, 2. 186 – Sreerampur, 3. 187 – Champdani, 4. 188 – Singur, 5. 189 – Chandannagar, 6. 190 – Chunchura, 7. 191 - Balagarh (SC), 8. 192 – Pandua, 9. 193 – Saptagram, 10. 194 - Chanditala under the jurisdiction of Hooghly District w.e.f from 6.30 P.M. of 08/04/2019 (P-2 day of Poll) till the end of 4th Phase of Poll:-


1. Assembly of Five or more persons excluding the persons who are voters in queue for the said Election, entitled to vote at the above stated polling Stations within 100 Meters of the Polling station and for maintenance of law and order in and around the premises.
2. The use of Micro phone/Loudspeaker/Cellular phone within 100 Meters of the venues excluding the officials drafted for election duties.
3. Carrying of fire arms, banners, lathis or such others articles in and around 100 Meters of the Polling stations excluding the security personnel drafted for election duties.
4. Any such other activities which may disturb the process of Polling/Election,

Police is empowered to take necessary action against a person or group of persons if they are found violating this order.

This order shall not apply to agencies/Officials of the Government involved in the enforcement of Law & Order, conduction of Election and maintenance of essential services.

This order will take immediate effect and shall remain in force till completion of the Poll. Let this order be served upon all concerned.
