

**ORDER**

**Whereas**, the State Govt. has issued the Himachal Pradesh Epidemic Disease (COVID-19) Regulations, 2020 vide Notification No. HFW-A-A(3)1/2020 Dated 11-03-2020 for the containment and prevention of the spread of COVID-19.

**Whereas**, the State Government had notified a Lock Down in the territories jurisdiction of the State of HP in public interest vide Order No.HFW-A-A(3)1/2020 Dated 23-03-2020, with effect from 23-03-2020 till further orders.

**Whereas**, it is imperative to put in place strict measures of isolation and social distancing to contain the spread of COVID-19 in the district as a lot of non-essential movement of people and vehicles has been reported inspite of the lockdown thereby defeating the very purpose of a lock down.

**And Whereas**, I, am satisfied that such movement poses a serious threat to public health by the spread of (COVID-19) which poses a danger to human life, health and safety.

**And therefore**, I, AmitKashyap, IAS, District Magistrate, Shimla in exercise of powers conferred in me under Section 144 of Cr. PC, hereby impose CURFEW in the area of District Shimla. **No person shall leave his / her home or shall move on foot or by vehicle or travel or stand or roam around on any road or public places (except for emergency medical aid).** Further, any assembly of five or more persons shall not be allowed anywhere in the district.

However, this order shall not be applicable to the following:-

1. Government servants on Magisterial Duty and District Disaster Management Authority.
2. Health Officials.
3. Fire Service(s).
4. Police, Military, Para Military Forces and other security forces which are under the control of State or Central Government.
5. Government or Semi Government Employees on duty pertaining to mitigation of COVID-19 as certified by concerned Sub-Divisional Magistrate.
6. Electricity, Water and Municipal services.
7. Bank / ATM.
8. Telecom and internet services including IT and ITaS






This order shall come into force with immediate effect in the entire area of Shimla district and shall remain in force till further orders.

In view of the emergent nature of the order, it is being issued ex-parte and addressed to the Public in general.

The compliance of this order shall be ensured by the Executive Magistrates (including those especially appointed) and Police Officers / officials. Violation of this order shall attract provisions of Section 188 of IPC and the violator can be prosecuted under Section 269 and 279 of IPC which provide for imprisonment for 6 months or with a fine or both and an imprisonment which may extend upto 2 years or fine respectively.


