| 1 | <b>Blood Donation Services</b>                    | During the year under report, this branch organised 33 voluntary blood donation camps with the collaboration various societies, NGOs, educational institutes and collected 2874 units of blood. An amount of Rs. 20,411/- was paid to the organizer on a/c of refreshment charges.  |
| 2 | <b>Relief Services</b>                            | The society distributed jerseys & Sweters of Rs. 17,030/- to the orphan, mentally retorted & physically handicap childrens of Anchal Chaya Anath Ashram, Baghola, Palwal. An amount of Rs. 39,432/- was sent to chief minister relief fund of Haryana on a/c of Utrakhand calamities victims and an amount of Rs. 5,000/- was paid on a/c of transportation charges of funeral van for transport deadbody from General Hospital, Palwal to PGI, Rohtak.   |
| 3 | <b>Services for disabled persons</b>              | Our aim is to make the disabled persons stand on their feet and build up confidence in them. During the year under report, 2 measurement camp for physically disabled persons were organised on 8-9 April & 15-17 November, 2013 with the help of ALIMCO, Kanpur & various NGOs of District. In the both camps approximately 900 disabled persons were registered and 550 were identified for appliances. | 7  | <b>Awareness Programme</b>   | During the year under report, this branch organized various awareness programme with help of NSS units and YRC units of various college for Blood Donation & Human organs, Social evils i.e. female foeticide, HIV/AIDS, use of poly bags etc. by conducting rallies and meeting.   |
| 8  | <b>Night Shelters</b>  | During the year, in winter seasons this branch started to continue 7 temporary Nights Shelter at Block level with the help of religious NGOs and social workers to provide shelter to the homeless people, passengers and 80 Quits purchased of Rs. 32,800/- and provided to these shelters.  |
| 9  | <b>Misuse of Red Cross Emblem</b>  | During the year, this branch efforts to stop the misuse of Red Cross Emblem by unauthorized persons by personally visits with general public and displayed stickers/posters at prominent places and pumplets got distributed amongst chemist shop and Nursing Homes.  |
