

ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973

WHEAEAS information has been laid before me that Novel Corona virus (COVID-19) continues to spread around the country, which is dangerous to human life. In the light of this fact, prevention appears to be the best cure available so far. Accordingly, Government of India and Govt. of Haryana have issued various instructions under Disaster Management Act, 2005 directing the authorities to take effective measures so as to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Wearing masks/face covers in public/work places is now compulsory across the country to avoid infection of COVID-19 as corona virus spreads through respiratory droplets released when an infected persons coughs, sneezes and speaks or through droplets of saliva or discharge from the nose. Hence, scientific disposal of masks, gloves, and others PPE is most important to stop the spreading of viruses and other diseases. The CPCB and Haryana State Pollution Control Board has issued the guidelines/advisory vide letter No. HSPCB/HQ/SWM/2020/94-96 dated 16.04.2020 regarding handling, Treatment and disposal of Waste Generated during Treatment/Diagnosis/Quarantine of COVID-19 patients and special cleaning of public places, safe disposal of waste from quarantined households, safe disposal of masks and other related waste from non-quarantined households, welfare and protection of Sanitary workers engaged in collection and transportation of COVID-19 waste. It has been observed that people at large are at risk of getting infected by coming into contact with the people who are already suffering from it.

And whereas it has been made appear to me that there is a need to impose restriction to contain the further spread of COVID-19. I am satisfied from the material placed before me that there are sufficient grounds for proceedings under **The Disaster Management Act, 2005 and section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973**, and that immediate prevention is desirable to prevent COVID-19.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon and delegated to me under Section 2, 30 and 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 I, **Naresh Narwal, IAS, District Magistrate, Palwal -cum-Chairperson, of the District Disaster Management Authority, Palwal** hereby order to ensure strict implementation of following restrictions in the limits of District Palwal:-

1. PPE like face masks, gloves etc. being used Healthcare Facilities, Quarantine Camps/Quarantine-homes/ Home-care, Sample Collection Centre's, Laboratories be collected in especially marked yellow garbage bags and be disposed of through authorised common Bio Medical Waste Treatment Facilities in rural and urban areas.
2. Waste such as used masks and gloves etc. generating from domestic household and officers/officials/employees on duty in the field is also be treated as Bio-Medical Waste and be collected separately in especially marked yellow garbage bags or closed dustbin without mixing with normal household/domestic waste. This waste should be kept at designated places with wrapping in separate wrapper and shall be disposed off through authorized Common Bio Medical Waste Treatment Facilities engaged by Urban Local Body and Local Authority.

Superintendent of Police, Palwal, ADC, all SDMs, all Duty Magistrates i.e. Incident Commanders, Tehsildars/ Naib Tehsildars, BDPOs, Civil Surgeon, DDPO, BDPOs, Executive Officers/Secretary Municipal Council/Committee, and SHOs are directed for strict and immediate compliance of above orders in their respective areas.

This order shall be applicable in the entire area of the District Palwal and shall come into force from **27.04.2020 till further orders.**



If any person is found guilty of the violation of this order he shall be punishable under section 188 of Indian Penal Code and section 51 to 60 of Disaster Management Act, 2005.


