

ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973

Whereas, W.H.O. has declared the recent Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) as an epidemic because of Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC). To mitigate the risk of COVID-19, contact/gathering of people in large numbers need to be restricted.

And whereas, it is essential that opening of all Educational Institutions, Cinema, Pubs and Gym's etc. where a large number of people are likely to gather at the same time should be restricted to prevent such danger to human health and safety in view of above Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic.

And whereas the undersigned is satisfied that immediate measures are needed to be taken for prevention of such danger of human health and safety relating to me General Public.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the undersigned by virtue of Section 144 or code of Criminal Procedure 1973, I, District Magistrate, Palwal do hereby order that all Educational Institutional, (Private/Government/CBSE Schools, College, I.T.I.'s), Cinemas, Pubs and Gym's etc. where a large number of people are likely to gather at the same time and which is operating within the district Palwal shall remain closed with immediate effect upto 31.03.2020 or till further orders, whichever is earlier.


This order shall not apply on already scheduled external exams and that cannot be changed by the management of schools/colleges at local level.

Superintendent of Police, Palwal, All SDMs District Palwal, Principals for all colleges, ITI's, ITOT's situated in Palwal, District Education Officer and District Elementary Education Officer, Palwal shall be responsible for the compliance of the above orders.

In view of the emergent situation and shortage of time, this order is being passed exparte. If any person is found guilty of the violation of this order he shall be prosecuted and punished under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.

District Information and Public Relation Officer, Palwal shall give wide publicity of this order within the District Palwal through print and electronic media.
