

ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973

Whereas, the COVID-19 has been declared as pandemic by the World Health Organization and National Disaster management Authority, being satisfied that the country is threatened with the COVID-19 pandemic;

And whereas, it is evident that there has been an experimental surge in COVID-19 cases in Palwal district necessary measures are to be adopted to contain the spread of the Covid-19 and also to ensure minimum collateral damage to the system.

The Government of Haryana has considered it necessary to take effective measures to prevent and contain the spread of the Covid-19 virus in the State including district Palwal in the interest of maintenance of public health, hygiene and safety

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, I, Satyender Duhan, HCS, District Magistrate, Palwal, do hereby strictly prohibit the gathering of more than four persons, throughout the revenue limits of district Palwal, unless specifically permitted.

This order shall not apply on police force and other public servants on duty, persons of medical industries/institutions, persons working in sectors related to essential products/services.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect.

The order shall be disseminated for the information of general public and promulgated within the revenue limits of District Palwal through publicity van of Public Relations Department and also by affixing copies of this order at District, Sub Divisional, Tehsil Courts, Police Stations and other public places as well.

Any person(s) contravening this order will be liable to be proceeded against under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860. Superintendent of Police, Palwal shall implement this order.
