Sub:- Disaster Management- ensuring enough currency dispensing through ATMs / bank branches- reg.

It is understood that there will be a long stretch of Bank Holidays, occurring from 22nd August onwards. 22, 24, 25, 26, 27 and 28 happens to be holidays.

Those people, who were evacuated and accommodated in relief camps will start to go back home, from next week onwards. The financial assistance, from government, for the victims of the disaster will be dispersed through DBT through banks. So, the following instructions are issued under section 30(1), 34(a) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 for strict compliance.

- i) All bank branches should ensure that the ATM/Cash Dispensing Machines under their control are filled with cash, so as to ensure enough availability of cash during these days
- ii) A mechanism shall be made operational for ensuring the replenishing of ATMs during this period. The Lead District Manager shall co-ordinate with other banks on this matter.
- Those banks, which are dealing with the cash transaction of Tahsildar, Sulthan Bathery/ Mananthavadi/Vythiri shall make arrangements for transferring of funds to the beneficiary accounts even during holidays. The necessary minimum machinery of these bank branches shall be made operational, in consultation with the concerned Tahsildars. Contact number of Tahsildars is S.Bathery 9447097707, Vythiri- 9447097705, Mananthavadi- 9447097704. The Lead District Manager shall co-ordinate and do the necessary liaison to ensure this.
