

Therefore, considering the significance of the situation ,it is ordered that, a barricade should be erected at the border of Kerala state with immediate effect by the Forest Department. Police is also directed to support the Wild Life Warden,Sulthan bathery, at the check point erected to prevent unauthorized entry of persons to the State.
