under Sec.70(1).Today also there was no mention about the vehicle by the applicant.There was more than 20 objections stating that the route is a city service route and a portion of the route is narrow to accommodate stage carriages and a congested area etc. There was also objection regarding the service may constitute danger to public and portion of the route from Niveditha to Chullikad is having no road fitness.

The enquiry officer reported this is city permit and as per GO(p) No.27/2000 Trans dtd.19-9-2000. The number of permits are restricted and no further permit can be granted.Hence **rejected**.

There is an overlapping of 2.2km on nationalised route and only a single trip provided through Kanniparamba from Kozhikode to Mukkam for a distance of 20km.The total daily mileage comes only 177kmrs.

No evidencec produced on the allegation that there is permit trafficking and hence the same is over ruled.The applicant offered further trips to Areekode today,but not submitted such a modified time schedule.The report of the field officer (sketch) is defective for want of specific marking of overlapping portion.Hence the matter **adjourned** with following direction.

- (1) The secretary RTA shall ascertain the feasibility of providing more trips in consultation with the applicant.
- (2) Secretary RTA is directed to offer detailed report in this regard.
- (3) The enquiry officer concerned is directed to offer his remarks before this Authirity in person for the lapse of non marking of nationalised portion in the route sketch.

With a view to achieve this objective the STA decided to fix the life of ordinary stage carriage services with limited stops as 10 years (ten) from the date of original registration of the vehicle.'

While considering the item in detail some stage carriage operators objected the reduction of age from 15 years to 10 years. We remember that there was application by the existing operators before this authority to fix age limit of all stage carriages applying for fresh permit to five years. And it is understood that the STA has taken the decision after conducting detailed study and hearing the connected parties. Hence the objections are found as not sustainable.

In this context the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India is of the view that, fixing of age to vehicles is obviously in the public interest because, old vehicles can cause accidents and inconvenience (2010(4) KLT 597 – Supreme Court). Further the fast growing technological development shall not be refused to public and we have to consider the latest Judgment of National Green Tribunal also into account in this case.

Hence life span of stage carriages of limited stop ordinary services is fixed as ten years from the date of original registration in view of the above. The existing (LSOS) vehicles which are completed ten years shall be replaced within a period of one year or at the time of renewal of permit whichever comes earlier.

This item came up for the consideration of this authority, consequent up on an application dated 6.2.2015 of Koduvally- Thamarassery- Narikkuni Mekhala Bus Operators Association(KDBOA) with a request to review the decision(temporary traffic arrangement) taken on 14.11.2014 by this RTA vide item No.94, with the reasoning that they are suffering fuel loss and other losses; there is no uniformity in running stage carriages,categorizing of vehicles on the distance traversed is not rational or logical and discriminatory etc.

Though there was prevention of services of Stage Carriages having route length more than 25 kms through Arayaathupalam Flyover vide decision dated 14.11.2014 vide item No.94, there was allegation that this is not implemented properly. Kozhikode District Bus Operators Association, Medical College Unit, moved by filing WPC No.5650/16 before the Honourable High Court to implement the decision dated 14.11.2014 strictly. The court directed this authority to finalise the related pending matter before this authority within a time frame and to implement the same by R3, R4 in the writ petition 5650/16.

Heard. Advocate K.V. Gopinathan Nair the learned Council represented the applicant here in. There was request from various corners of public such as PTA Rahim, MLA, Karat Rasak MLA, Priests of St. George Church, Chembakulam, Priests of Holly Family Church, Vembala, Chair person of Koduvally Municipality, representatitives of various Grama Panchayath such as Madavoor, Thamarassery, Koodaranhi, Kodenchery, Omassery, Thiruvambady etc., to allow the request.

There are also several representations against the grant of request. Heard the representators including representation of Kozhikode District Bus Operators Association. The petitioner in WPC No.5650/2016 and Kozhikode District Bus Operators Association, the petitioner in WPC No.5650/2016 and Kozhikode Bus Operators Organisation.

The District Unit of Bus Operators Organisation requested not to change the existing situation as the same is arrived after a long and detailed meeting and discussion with the Bus Operators and various fractions of society such as people's representatives, leaders of Trade Union, Police etc., Consequent upon a Judgment of Honourable High Court in WPC No.27123/2014.

The District Bus Operators Association Medical College Unit represented and submitted that the request of applicant cannot be considered as the road in front of Mofussil Bus Stand has not undergone development progress including widening since 1994. There is always congestion and traffic block at Rajaji junction and any change in the existing situation will worsen the traffic problem. They requested to dismiss the request of the applicant. In view of the application and the Judgment dated 24.2.2106 in WPC No. 5650/2016, this authority resolves as follows”:-

In this context he recommendations of the District Road Safety Concil under the KRS Act in their meeting held on 10.6.2016 has been received, where under it has been suggested that the status-co ante as on 16.2.2016 shall be maintained so as to ensure smooth flow of traffic in Kozhikode City.

The matter considered in detail in the light of above recommendations also **and it is finally decided that all Stage Carriages including city services and all mofussil Stage Carriages coming from south which traverses not more that 25km in route length are permitted to ply over Arayadathpalam Fly Over through Mavoor Road, road in front of Mofussil Bus Stand Pavamani Road, CPO Junction and to Palayam Bus Stand and these Stage Carriages shall stop at west**

side of Mofussil stand on Rajaji Raod near Milma Booth instead of Mavoov Road. The other services from south via Medical college shall traverse through Arayidathpalam, Kalluthankadavu, Poorthanam Junction, Chinthavalappu, CPO Junction and then proceed to Palayam Bus Stand. The request of Narikkuni, Thamarassery, Koduvally Mekhala Bus Operators Association dated 6.2.2016 stands rejected.

This item was considered and adjourned on 16-2-2016. Now it is reported that the matter considered in Road Safety Council held on 10-6-2016 and decided as follows.

The required data are not available at present before this authority. The secretary RTA is directed to take necessary steps to speed up for the above report. Hence **adjourned.**
