

MINUTES OF THE FIFTH MEETING OF THE DISTRICT LEVEL MONITORING COMMITTEE(DLMC) HELD ON 21.12.2020 AT THE CHAMBER OF THE DEPUTY COLLECTOR, DISASTER MANAGEMENT, COLLECTORATE, KOZHIKODE.

The meeting of the Fifth District Level Monitoring Committee (DLMC for short) commenced at 11 AM at the chamber of Deputy Collector, Disaster Management. Smt. Shamin Sebastian, the Nodal officer, District Level Monitoring Committee and Deputy Collector Disaster Management welcomed all the members of the DLMC. She enquired about the decision taken in the fourth DLMC meeting and started discussing each resolution.

Smt. Shabna Kushe Shekhar the convener DLMC and the Environmental Engineer, KSPCB informed that even through the National Green Tribunal, in its order dated 25.04.2019 and 27.02.2020 has stated that all the local bodies of the state has to be fully compliant in Solid Waste Management Rules 2016, within one year from the date of order, some of the LSGDs in the district are not yet having MCF/MRF facilities, 100% door to door collection in house hold and establishment and the activities of Haritha Karma Sena is not effectively carried out in many LSGDs. She also informed that 27 LSGDs have not yet provided proper MCF facilities and about 30 LSGDs have <50% door to door collections in house hold even after repeated instructions and meetings. Smt. Soorya, Shuchithwa Mission, District Coordinator informed that the fund of Suchitwa Mission is already sanctioned to various LSGDs for providing decentralized Solid Waste Management facilities, but the local bodies have not yet utilized the same. Sri. Shaji, Deputy Director, Panchayath informed that though they are giving frequent instructions to the Secretaries of LSGDs, they have various constraints in implementing the same and it is better to call a meeting with the President, Standing Committee Chairmen of all LSGDs through online, video conference by the Hon'ble District Collector himself and make

them aware of the Solid Waste Management Rules 2016, its significances, standing orders of the National Green Tribunal and consequences if the order NGT is not complied with.

The DLMC members in the above meeting decided to hold the next DLMC meeting to be presided by the Hon'ble District Collector himself and to find a suitable day for holding meeting with Presidents of all LSGDs of the Kozhikode district.

The Nodal officer thanked all the participants and meeting came to an end by 11:30 PM
