**(Covid-19 Control Room)**

Keeping in view the larger public interest in the scenario of emerging threat of pandemic of Covid-19, in continuation to earlier order No Covid-19/6386-6436 dated 20-04-2021 and keeping in view the latest guidelines received from the Government of Punjab, Department of Home Affairs and Justice, Chandigarh vide no 7/56/2021/2H4/2069 dated 27.04.2021(Copy enclosed). I, Gurpreet Singh Khaira, IAS, District Magistrate, Amritsar in exercise of powers conferred upon me under section 144 of CrPC 1973 and National Disaster Management Act, 2005 order that following additional restrictions would be effective w.e.f. 27st April 2021 :-

- (A)1. All shops including those in malls and multiplexes etc. to close everyday by 5.00 pm with home delivery allowed upto 9.00 pm.
2. Daily Night curfew (already in force from 8 pm to 5 am) shall now be from 6 pm to 5 am on all days prohibiting all the non-essential activities.
3. Week-end curfew from 5.00 am on Saturday upto 5 am on Monday. However, all the essential activities shall remain exempted.
4. All private offices including service industry allowed to work from home only.
- (B). The following activities shall, subject however to observance of covid appropriate behaviour by all concerned, be exempted from Covid restrictions mentioned above:-
1. Chemist shops and shops dealing with supply of essential goods like milk, dairy products, vegetables, fruits etc.
2. **Manufacturing industry.**  
Movement of employees/labour of manufacturing industry and vehicles carrying them is allowed. However, concerned industry shall issue them requisite permission for the purpose.
3. 'To and fro' movement of passengers travelling via air, trains, buses etc.
4. Construction activities in both the Urban and rural areas.
5. Agricultural including procurement, horticultural, animal husbandry, veterinary services.
6. E-commerce and movement of all goods.
7. Vaccination out-reach camps.

(C). Commissioner of Police and Senior Superintendent of Police, ( Rural) and all SDM's shall also continue to ensure strict implementation of all extant directives of MHA/ State Government on Covid appropriate behaviour including social distancing norm of minimum 6 feet distance (2 Gaz Ki Doori), regulating crowds in market places of Covid appropriate behaviour like wearing of face masks and spitting in public places etc.

Any violations shall invite criminal proceedings under the relevant provisions of the Disaster Management Act 2005 and the Indian Penal Code 1860.

**Sub: Additional restrictions regarding Covid applicable w.e.f. 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2021 till further orders.**


1. In continuation to this office letter No. 7/56/2020/2H4/1968 dated the 19th April 2021 in the subject matter which shall be enforced till further orders.
2. In addition to the restrictions as imposed vide letter referred to hereinabove, the following additional restrictions shall be strictly and meticulously enforced throughout the State w.e.f. 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2020 till further orders:-
  - (i) All shops including those in malls and multiplexes etc. to close everyday by 5.00 pm with home delivery allowed upto 9.00 pm.
  - (ii) Daily Night curfew (already in force from 8 pm to 5 am) shall now be from 6 pm to 5 am on all days prohibiting all the non-essential activities.
  - (iii) Week-end curfew from 5.00 am on Saturday upto 5 am on Monday. However, all the essential activities shall remain exempted.
  - (iv) All private offices including service industry allowed to 'work from home' only.
3. The following activities shall, subject however to observance of covid appropriate behaviour by all concerned, be exempted from Covid restrictions mentioned in para 2 above:-
  - (i) Chemist shops and shops dealing with supply of essential goods like milk, dairy products, vegetables, fruits etc.
  - (ii) Manufacturing industry.  
Movement of employees/labour of manufacturing industry and vehicles carrying them is allowed. However, concerned industry shall issue them requisite permission for the purpose.



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- (iii) 'To and fro' movement of passengers travelling via air, trains, buses etc.
- (iv) Construction activities in both the Urban and rural areas.
- (v) Agricultural including procurement, horticultural, animal husbandry, veterinary services.
- (vi) E-commerce and movement of all goods.
- (vii) Vaccination out-reach camps.

4. District authorities shall also continue to ensure strict implementation of all the extant directives of MHA/State Government on Covid appropriate behaviour including social distancing norm of minimum 6 feet distance (Do Gaz Ki Doori), regulating crowds in market places and public transport, and imposition of penalties prescribed for violation of Covid appropriate behaviour like wearing of face masks and spitting in public places etc..
