
## (Covid-19 Control Room)

In continuation to this office order dated 27.04.2021 issued vide Endst No. Covid-19/7193-7243 dated 27-04-2021 and clarification in regard to additional restrictions regarding Covid applicable w.r.f. 27th April, 2021 received from the Government of Punjab, Department of Home Affairs and Justice (Home-4 Branch), Chandigarh vide their letter no 7/56/2020/2H4/2090 dated 27.04.2021 (Copy enclosed), it is clarified that all marriages scheduled after 6 pm on or before 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2021 shall continue to be permitted subject to the following conditions:-

- i) Not more than 20 people shall be allowed to attend the marriage.
- ii) Attendees shall have to get a curfew pass from Covid-19 Control Room situated at Red Cross Bhawan, Amritsar.
- iii) Function should conclude by 09:00 pm.

The dates/timing of all marriages scheduled on or after 1st May, 2021 may be rescheduled by the respective families to bring them in conformity with the notified Covid restrictions.



**Sub: Clarification in regard to additional restrictions regarding Covid applicable w.e.f. 27<sup>th</sup> April 2021 till further orders.**

1. Reference this office letter No.7/56/2020/2H4/2069 dated 27<sup>th</sup> April 2021 ( copy attached) in the subject matter.
2. In this context, it is clarified that all marriages scheduled after 6 pm on or before 30<sup>th</sup> April 2021 shall continue to be permitted subject to the following conditions:-
  - (i) Not more than 20 people shall be allowed to attend the marriage.
  - (ii) Attendees shall have to get a curfew pass issued from the District Magistrate or any officer authorised by him in this regard.
  - (iii) Function should conclude by 9.00 pm.
3. The dates/timings of all marriages scheduled on or after 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2021 may be rescheduled by the respective families to bring them in conformity with the notified Covid restrictions.

**Sub: Additional restrictions regarding Covid applicable w.e.f. 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2021 till further orders.**

1. In continuation to this office letter No. 7/56/2020/2H4/1968 dated the 19th April 2021 in the subject matter which shall be enforced till further orders.

2. In addition to the restrictions as imposed vide letter referred to hereinabove, the following additional restrictions shall be strictly and meticulously enforced throughout the State w.e.f. 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2021 till further orders:-

- (i) All shops including those in malls and multiplexes etc. to close everyday by 5.00 pm with home delivery allowed upto 9.00 pm.
- (ii) Daily Night curfew (already in force from 8 pm to 5 am) shall now be from 6 pm to 5 am on all days prohibiting all the non-essential activities.
- (iii) Week-end curfew from 5.00 am on Saturday upto 5 am on Monday. However, all the essential activities shall remain exempted.
- (iv) All private offices including service industry allowed to 'work from home' only.


3. The following activities shall, subject however to observance of covid appropriate behaviour by all concerned, be exempted from Covid restrictions mentioned in para 2 above:-

- (i) Chemist shops and shops dealing with supply of essential goods like milk, dairy products, vegetables, fruits etc.
- (ii) Manufacturing industry.  
Movement of employees/labour of manufacturing industry and vehicles carrying them is allowed. However, concerned industry shall issue them requisite permission for the purpose.



- (iii) 'To and fro' movement of passengers travelling via air, trains, buses etc.
- (iv) Construction activities in both the Urban and rural areas.
- (v) Agricultural including procurement, horticultural, animal husbandry, veterinary services.
- (vi) E-commerce and movement of all goods.
- (vii) Vaccination out-reach camps.

4. District authorities shall also continue to ensure strict implementation of all the extant directives of MHA/State Government on Covid appropriate behaviour including social distancing norm of minimum 6 feet distance (Do Gaz Ki Doori), regulating crowds in market places and public transport, and imposition of penalties prescribed for violation of Covid appropriate behaviour like wearing of face masks and spitting in public places etc..
