1. Army Recruitment Rally will be held for eligible candidates of districts **Udhampur, Rajouri, Poonch, Reasi, Ramba Doda, Kishtwar, Jammu, Samba and Kathua** from **10 February 2021 to 10 March 2021** at Jorawar Stadium, Sunjuwan Military Station, Jammu. Gates will be opened by 07:00 hours and closed by 10:00 hours on each day. Online registration is mandatory and has been completed from 05 March 2020 to 21 April 2020 on Indian Army website [www.joinindianarmy.nic.in](http://www.joinindianarmy.nic.in). Admit Cards for the rally will be sent through registered e-mail. Candidates should reach the venue on given date and time as mentioned in the Admit Card. Candidates will be screened for following **Categories** and as per **Qualitative Requirements** mentioned below:-

2. Candidates are required to bring following documents / certificates in original with two attested photocopies with them to the rally site:-
- Admit Card.** Printed with Laser Printer on good quality paper (Do not shrink the size).
  - Photograph.** Twenty copies of unattested Passport size color photographs in white background. Sikh candidates should bring 20 copies with turban and 20 copies without turban photographs.
  - Education Certificates.** Education Certificates with marks sheet in original of all educational qualifications achieved by candidate i.e. Matric Intermediate / Graduation etc from recognised School / College / Board / University.
  - State Subject Certificate (Permanent Resident Certificate).** State Subject Certificate (Permanent Residential Certificate) issued by district administration.
  - Caste Certificate.** Caste Certificate with community and religion affixed with photograph of the candidate issued by the Tehsildar / District Magistrate, e.g. Dogra / Hindu.
  - Religion Certificate.** Religion Certificate issued by the Tehsildar / SDM. (If religion as "SIKH / HINDU / MUSLIM / CHRISTIAN" is not mentioned caste certificate).
  - School Character Certificate.** School Character Certificate issued by the School / College Principal / Headmaster, where the candidate last studied is presently studying.
  - Character Certificate.** Character Certificate with photograph issued by Village Sarpanch / Municipal Corporation within last six months.
  - Unmarried Certificate.** Unmarried Certificate for candidates less than 21 years of age with photograph issued by Village Sarpanch / Municipal Corporation within last six months.
  - Relationship Certificate.** SOS / SOEX / SOW / SOWW Candidates are required to produce the Relationship Certificate issued from respective Record Office only duly signed by Record Officer with Personal number, Rank, Name with office seal/stamp is endorsed.
  - NCC Certificate.** NCC A / B / C certificates and Republic Day Parade.
  - Sports Certificate.** The following sports certificates issued by authorized sports federations are valid for two years from the issue date as on first date of the recruitment for which the candidate is being screened:-
    - Sportsmen who have represented India at International level within the last two years.
    - Sportsmen who have represented State at the Senior/Junior National level and have won any medal in individual event or have reached up to eighth position in the Team event.
    - Sportsmen who have represented College/University in Inter University Championship and have won any medal in individual event or have reached up to sixth position in the Team event.
    - Sportsmen who have represented State at National Level in Khelo India Games and have won any medal in individual event or have reached up to sixth position in the Team event.
    - Sportsmen who have represented District at the State Level and have won any medal in individual event or have reached up to fourth position in the Team event.
    - Sportsmen who have represented State School team in the events organised by All India School Games Federation and have won any medal in individual event or have reached up to sixth position in the Team event.
  - Self Affidavit.** Self declaration on affidavit as per Rally Notification format available on Indian Army website.
  - PAN Card & AADHAR Card.**
  - COVID-19 Free / Asymptomatic Certificate and No Risk Certificate.** COVID-19 Free / Asymptomatic Certificate and No Risk Certificate as per Rally Notification format available on Indian Army website.

**NOTE**

- Entry only by Admit Card generated online. Anyone found with fake admit card will be handed over to Civil Police.**
- Certificates with overwriting, tampering will not be accepted.
- Candidates appear in the Rally at own risk. No compensation for death / injury / loss etc is admissible.
- Use of Performance Enhancing Drugs.** Drug test will be conducted during Rally. Candidates having found to have used the same will be debarred from further screening.
- Tattoo.** Permanent body tattoos are only permitted on inner face of forearms i.e. from inside of elbow to the wrist and on the reverse side of palm / back (dorsal) side of hand. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body are not acceptable.
- MOBILE PHONES / BAGS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE RALLY SITE.**
