Animal Husbandry Department is headed by Chief Animal Husbandry Officer Reasi Dr. Ajay Sharma. This department provides the basic health services to the livestock population of district Reasi viz. Treatment, Vaccination, Deworming etc. Further for Genetic Upgradation of Bovine population of the district, department provides Artificial Insemination services as well as Community bulls of improved breeds. To increase the living status of livestock farmers various schemes are provided through this department. Backyard poultry units are also established by this department.
