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ORDER

Sub: Imposition of Corona Curfew in District Reasi w.e.f 29/04/2021 (7:00 pm) to 03/05/2021 (7:00 am).

- 1) Whereas, a detailed review of the current COVID situation in Reasi district was conducted by the District Disaster Management Authority, Reasi with respect to the current positivity rate, hospital bed occupancy and total active cases; and
- 2) Whereas, on account of the above, the District Disaster Management Authority is of the considered view that stringent containment measures are required to be taken at a macro level in order to restrict the movement and inter mingling of people, thereby limiting the chain of transmission;
- 3) Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 34 of the National Disaster Management Act, 2005, the undersigned in his capacity as the Chairperson of the District Disaster Management Authority, Reasi hereby order that there shall be a complete 'Corona' curfew across the entire jurisdiction of Reasi w.e.f 7:00 pm on 29/04/2021 to 7:00 am on 03/05/2021. The following activities shall be permissible and non-permissible during the said period of Corona Curfew.

(A) Permissible Activities

- i. All essential services including all incidental services and activities needed for smooth functioning of these activities shall be allowed to continue, both in the public and private sector. There shall be no restriction on the movement of the people to buy their daily groceries and essentials. The wholesalers, Fruit & Sabzi mandies may also remain open and functional to ensure provisioning of essential supplies.
- ii. Restaurants in hotels can remain functional for in-house guests, to be served only in the rooms.
- iii. There will be no hindrance to the smooth movement of goods and essential supplies, nomads migrating with herds, Darbar Move Officials/ staff, and other products like agricultural / horticultural goods, on the National & State Highways.
- iv. There shall be no restriction on interstate and intra state movement of essential goods.
- v. All Industrial and Scientific establishment, both Public & Private, are allowed to operate for production purposes, or otherwise. Internet services, IT, Telecom, IT enabled services' sector, including e-Commerce are permitted.
- vi. There shall be no restriction on the movement of Government Officials for attending office/ duties, on production of I-Cards/ Official Orders.
- vii. All development/ construction works shall be allowed to continue without any hindrance.
- viii. The vaccination drive shall not be halted. Localized mobile teams shall be constituted to provide vaccination in colonies, residential areas and containment zones.

(B) Non-Permissible/ Restricted Activities in entire District,

- i. There shall be a complete 'Corona' curfew with no movement of people except for permissible activities only, as mentioned above.
- ii. All Educational institutions are already closed and shall continue to remain closed.
- iii. All Shopping Complexes, Bazaars, Saloons, Barber Shops, Cinema Halls, Restaurants & Bars, Sport Complexes, Gyms, Spas, Swimming Pools, Parks, Zoos, etc, shall remain closed.
- iv. Religious & Social gatherings such as marriages, attended by upto 50 persons only, whether indoors or outdoors, and funerals / last rites, attended by upto 20 persons only, are allowed.
- v. Public transport shall be allowed to operate at a maximum of 50% capacity only and this shall be strictly enforced.

(C) Other Measures:

- i. Health Department will establish Telemedicine facilities for patients isolating at home. Dedicated Control room numbers for this shall be widely publicized.
- ii. Direct admission of patients in tertiary care hospitals shall be allowed only on referral from a district hospital except for emergencies. All COVID patients being admitted to tertiary hospitals in Jammu & Srinagar shall necessarily be based on referral from their respective District hospitals, except for grave emergencies.

4) Last but not the least, public at large is also being informed that **Section 51 of the Disaster Management Act** provides for penalties in case a person obstructs any officer or employee in discharge of his functions or refuses to comply with any direction given under this Act. Any violation of the above directions will, therefore, lead to prosecution under section 51 of the DM Act, 2005. SSP, Reasi, shall strictly enforce compliance to this order.
