Sub:- Directorate for Welfare of the Differently Abled, Chennai –
Announcement of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu Cash
Assistance of Rs.1,000/- considering the livelihood of differently
abled persons during the lock down period for 13.35 lakhs National
Identity and Disability Certificate holders (NIDC) – Additional
guidelines for those staying outside the native districts where the
NIDC cards has been registered- Issued.

In the reference 1st cited above, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu had
announced a cash assistance of Rs.1,000/- considering the livelihood of differently
abled persons during the lock down period towards 13.35 lakhs National Identity and
Disability Certificate holders (NIDC).

In this regard, vide reference 2nd above, Government had issued Order
sanctioning a sum of Rs.133,52,19,000/- (Rupees One Hundred and Thirty Three
Crores Fifty Two Lakhs and Nineteen Thousand Only) from the State Disaster
Response Fund (SDRF) to the District Collectors.

The Director for the Welfare of Differently Abled, Chennai vide reference 3rd
cited above, had issued certain guidelines towards the distribution of cash
assistance of Rs.1,000/- to the differently abled persons. In the guidelines it was
informed that the directions for payment for the persons with disabilities who are
currently staying outside the districts and not in their respective native districts will be
issued separately.

Accordingly all the District Differently Abled Welfare Officers are hereby instructed to distribute the cash relief of Rs.1,000/- for all the differently abled persons having the NIDC cards irrespective of their place of stay in the migrated district. Further an acknowledgement seal may be registered in their original card and the details may be communicated to the respective home district's District Differently Abled Welfare Officers, where the card has been registered. Both the Differently Abled Welfare Officers should ensure no duplication and the list has to be maintained. This guideline may be informed to the concerned distributing officer.
